How do God's people respond?

I. <u>Begin</u> with the / God's certainties!

<u>1 Samuel 14:6</u> And Jonathan said to the young man that bare his armour, Come, and let us go over unto the garrison of these uncircumcised: it may be that the LORD will work for us: <u>for</u> there is no restraint to the LORD to save by many or by few. <u>2 Chronicles 14:11</u> And Asa cried unto the LORD his God, and said, LORD, it is nothing with thee to help, whether with many, or with them that have no power: help us, O LORD our God; for we rest on thee, and in thy name we go against this multitude. O LORD, thou art our God; let not man prevail against thee.

<u>Jeremiah 32:17</u> Ah Lord GOD! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, and **there is nothing too hard for thee:**

Jeremiah 32:27 Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh: is there any thing too hard for me?

<u>Matthew 19:26</u> But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible. <u>Luke 1:37</u> For with God nothing shall be impossible.

Romans 8:37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.
