THOSE PESKY, IRRITATING, "OTHER" GROUPS! MARK 9:38-41

What do we learn from this event?

I. There are always those who are not with us!

<u>Mark 9:38</u> And John answered him, saying, **Master**, we saw one casting out devils in thy name, and he followeth <u>not</u> us: and we forbad him, because he followeth not us.

Thoughts:

- > This confuses us why don't they follow us?
- > This make us jealous
- > This may cause us to question us???
- > This doesn't make sense to us!
- ➤ This should cause us to reevaluate God's greatness, grace, & goodness!

<u>I Kings 19:10</u> And he said, I have been very jealous for the LORD God of hosts: for the children of Israel have forsaken thy covenant, thrown down thine altars, and slain thy prophets with the sword; and I, even I only, am left; and they seek my life, to take it away.

1 Kings 19:14 And he said, I have been very jealous for the LORD God of hosts: because the children of Israel have forsaken thy covenant, thrown down thine altars, and slain thy prophets with the sword; and I, even I only, am left; and they seek my life, to take it away. 1 Kings 19:15 And the LORD said unto him, Go, return on thy way to the wilderness of Damascus: and when thou comest, anoint Hazael to be king over Syria: 1 Kings 19:16 And Jehu the son of Nimshi shalt thou anoint to be king over Israel: and Elisha the son of Shaphat of Abelmeholah shalt thou anoint to be prophet in thy room. 1 Kings 19:17 And it shall come to pass, that him that escapeth the sword of Hazael shall Jehu slay: and him that escapeth from the sword of Jehu shall Elisha slay. 1 Kings 19:18 Yet I have left me seven thousand in Israel, all the knees which have not bowed unto Baal, and every mouth which hath not kissed him.

Romans 11:1 I say then, Hath God cast away his people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin. Romans 11:2 God hath not cast away his people which he foreknew. Wot ye not what the scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel, saying, Romans 11:3 Lord, they have killed thy prophets, and digged down thine altars; and I am left alone, and they seek my life. Romans 11:4 But what saith the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to the image of Baal. Romans 11:5 Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace.

> This will probably cause us to try to stop them...or at least...!

II. Those <u>not</u> with us are **not necessarily** against us!

<u>Mark 9:38</u> And John answered him, saying, **Master, we saw one casting out devils in thy name,** and he followeth not us: and we forbad him, <u>because</u> he followeth not us.

Galatians 1:6 I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel: Galatians 1:7 Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ. Galatians 1:8 But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. Galatians 1:9 As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

<u>Galatians 2:4</u> And that because of <u>false</u> brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage: <u>Galatians 2:5</u> To whom we gave place by subjection, no, not for an hour; that the truth of the gospel might continue with you.

<u>Philippians 3:18</u> (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: <u>Philippians 3:19</u> Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things.)

<u>Jude 3</u> Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints. <u>Jude 4</u> For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, <u>turning</u> the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and <u>denying</u> the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

Many, maybe most are not "with us!"

- Many departed from fundamental doctrines & therefore can't be with us
- > Some departed through compromise & don't want to be with us
- > Some from history &/ culture come from different places
- > Some from ignorance / lack of exposure

<u>Mark 9:38</u> And John answered him, saying, Master, we saw one casting out devils **in thy name**, and he followeth not us: and we forbad him, because he followeth not us.

Mark 9:39 But Jesus said, Forbid him not:

<u>for</u> there is no man which shall do a miracle in my name, that can lightly speak evil of me.

Mark 9:40 For he that is not against us is on our part.

<u>Mark 9:41 For</u> whosoever shall give you a cup of water to **drink in my name**, because ye belong to Christ, verily I say unto you, he shall not lose his reward.
