DAVID AND THE KINGSHIP 1 SAM. 16:13-23

What do we find?

I. David was called to be king!

<u>1 Samuel 16:1</u> And the LORD said unto Samuel, How long wilt thou mourn for Saul, seeing I have rejected him from reigning over Israel? fill thine horn with oil, and go, I will send thee to Jesse the Bethlehemite: for I have provided me a king among his sons. <u>1 Samuel 16:11</u> And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all thy children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, he keepeth the sheep. And Samuel said unto Jesse, Send and fetch him: for we will not sit down till he come hither. <u>1</u> Samuel 16:12 And he sent, and brought him in. Now he was ruddy, and withal of a beautiful countenance, and goodly to look to. And the LORD said, Arise, anoint him: for this is he. <u>1 Samuel 16:13</u> Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

<u>1 Samuel 16:14</u> But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him. <u>Thoughts:</u>

- David was chosen by God
- > David was chosen publicly
- David was anointed publicy
- > David's anointing was his symbolic calling and enabling
- > David was empowered by the Holy Spirit from that day forward
- > Saul was abandoned & disempowered by the Holy Spirit from that day forward

<u>1 Samuel 16:14</u> But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him.

<u>Psalm 51:11</u> Cast me <u>not</u> away from thy presence; and take <u>not</u> thy holy spirit from me.

<u>Judges 16:20</u> And she said, The Philistines be upon thee, Samson. And he awoke out of his sleep, and said, I will go out as at other times before, and shake myself. And he wist not that the LORD was departed from him.

David obviously knew all of this!

II. David was called...but not yet!

What went through David's mind? King? But how do I become king?

Most of the rest of the book will answer that question!

It would happen:

- > In God's time
- > Not by David's hands
- > Not by plots & plotting
- Not by murder

<u>1</u> Samuel 24:6 And he said unto his men, The LORD forbid that I should do this thing unto my master, the LORD'S anointed, to stretch forth mine hand against him, seeing he is the anointed of the LORD.

<u>1</u> Samuel 26:9</u> And David said to Abishai, Destroy him not: for who can stretch forth his hand against the LORD'S anointed, and be guiltless? **<u>1</u> Samuel 26:10** David said furthermore, As the LORD liveth, the LORD shall smite him; or his day shall come to die; or he shall descend into battle, and perish. **<u>1</u> Samuel 26:11** The LORD forbid that I should stretch forth mine hand against the LORD'S anointed: but, I pray thee, take thou now the spear that is at his bolster, and the cruse of water, and let us go.

- > But by & because of Saul's own choices
- > As God brought this to pass

"Rebels who ascend the throne by rebellion have no patience with other rebels and their rebellion."

III. David was called first to serve!

<u>1 Samuel 16:14</u> But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him. **<u>1 Samuel 16:15</u>** And Saul's servants said unto him, Behold now, an evil spirit from God troubleth thee. **<u>1 Samuel 16:16</u>** Let our lord now command thy

servants, which are before thee, to seek out a man, who is a cunning player on an harp: and it shall come to pass, when the evil spirit from God is upon thee, that he shall play with his hand, and thou shalt be well. **<u>1 Samuel 16:17</u>** And Saul said unto his servants, Provide me now a man that can play well, and bring him to me. **<u>1 Samuel 16:18</u>** Then answered one of the servants, and said, Behold, I have seen a son of Jesse the Bethlehemite, that is cunning in playing, and a mighty valiant man, and a man of war, and prudent in matters, and a comely person, and the LORD is with him. **<u>1 Samuel 16:19</u>** Wherefore Saul sent messengers unto Jesse, and said, Send me David thy son, which is with the sheep. **<u>1 Samuel 16:20</u>** And Jesse took an ass laden with bread, and a bottle of wine, and a kid, and sent them by David his son unto Saul. **<u>1 Samuel 16:21</u>** And David came to Saul, and stood before him: and he loved him greatly; and he became his armourbearer.

Thoughts:

- > David was serving before his call
- > David went back to serving after his call
- > David continued serving intermittently after serving Saul

<u>1 Samuel 16:11</u> And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all thy children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, he keepeth the sheep. And Samuel said unto Jesse, Send and fetch him: for we will not sit down till he come hither.
<u>1 Samuel 16:19</u> Wherefore Saul sent messengers unto Jesse, and said, Send me David thy son, which is with the sheep.
<u>1 Samuel 17:14</u> And David was the youngest: and the three eldest followed Saul. <u>1 Samuel 17:15</u> But David went and returned from Saul to feed his father's sheep at Bethlehem.

> David's brothers didn't value his service

<u>1 Samuel 17:28</u> And Eliab his eldest brother heard when he spake unto the men; and Eliab's anger was kindled against David, and he said, Why camest thou down hither? and with whom hast thou left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know thy pride, and the naughtiness of thine heart; for thou art come down that thou mightest see the battle. <u>1 Samuel 17:29</u> And David said, What have I now done? Is there not a cause?

IV. David was called to serve and therefore learn kingship⁺!

<u>1 Samuel 16:14</u> But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him.
 <u>1 Samuel 16:22</u> And Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Let David, I pray thee, stand before me; for he hath found favour in my sight. <u>1</u>
 <u>Samuel 16:23</u> And it came to pass, when the evil spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.

<u>1</u> Samuel 18:10 And it came to pass on the morrow, that the evil spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied in the midst of the house: and David played with his hand, as at other times: and there was a javelin in Saul's hand.

<u>1</u> Samuel 19:9 And the evil spirit from the LORD was upon Saul, as he sat in his house with his javelin in his hand: and David played with his hand.

Luke 16:10 He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much.

Luke 16:11 If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches?

Luke 16:12 And if ye have not been faithful in that which is another man's, who shall give you that which is your own?
