This would include all social media apart from face-to-face, in-depth relationships Plus most casual contacts Not wrong just not very much!

2. Beneficial | artificial

Mr. ______ is friends with Pastor ______ of LCBC &/ Pastor ______ of LCBS. He will also be friends with the next pastor / school administrator.

This is called **positional friendship** – friendship of the position!

Who does this hurt the most?

3. Circumstantial | situational

Work with Live near Go to the same church Interests in common

You are "friends" as long as you are here!!!

4. Emotional

I like| feel sorry for...! It is good to like your friend but is that really a friend? Friendship?

5. Functional – what we do

<u>John 15:12</u> This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you.<u>John 15:13</u> Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.<u>John 15:14</u> Ye are my friends, <u>if</u> ye do whatsoever I command you.<u>John 15:15</u> Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you.

So, how do I know if someone is a friend? Or, if I am a friend?

I. Jonathan took the initiative | left his comfort & safety

<u>1 Samuel 23:16</u> And Jonathan Saul's son arose, and went to David <u>into</u> the wood, and strengthened his hand in God.

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<u>Proverbs 17:17</u> A friend loveth at all times, and a brother is born for adversity.

Thoughts:

Friendship is inconvenient

- Friendship isn't all excitement
- > Friendship takes time
- Friendship requires sacrifice or giving up
- > Friendship requires leaving our comfort / routine

II. Jonathan strengthened his hand in God

<u>1 Samuel 23:16</u> And Jonathan Saul's son arose, and went to David into the wood, and strengthened his hand in God.

Proverbs 27:17 Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend.

III. Jonathan gave him hope & a future

<u>1 Samuel 23:17</u> And he said unto him, **Fear** <u>not</u>: for the hand of Saul my father shall <u>not</u> find thee; and thou <u>shalt</u> be king over Israel, and I shall be next unto thee; and that also Saul my father knoweth.

Proverbs 25:25 As cold waters to a thirsty soul, so is good news from a far country.

<u>Proverbs 27:9</u> Ointment and perfume rejoice the heart: so *doth* the sweetness of a man's friend by hearty counsel.

Words, notes, hugs, visits, meals, trips... The right thing The right time The right motive

Proverbs 25:11 A word fitly spoken *is like* apples of gold in pictures of silver.

IV. Jonathan confirmed his love & commitment

<u>1 Samuel 23:18</u> And they two made a covenant before the LORD: and David abode in the wood, and Jonathan went to his house.

<u>**1** Samuel 31:6</u> So Saul died, <u>and</u> his three sons, and his armourbearer, and all his men, that same day together.

<u>2 Samuel 9:1</u> And David said, Is there yet any that is left of the house of Saul, that I may shew him kindness for Jonathan's sake?

<u>2 Samuel 9:2</u> And *there was* of the house of Saul a servant whose name *was* Ziba. And when they had called him unto David, the king said unto him, *Art* thou Ziba? And he said, Thy servant *is he*.

<u>2 Samuel 9:3</u> And the king said, *Is* there not yet any of the house of Saul, that I may shew the kindness of God unto him? And Ziba said unto the king, Jonathan hath yet a son, *which is* lame on *his* feet.

<u>2 Samuel 9:4</u> And the king said unto him, Where *is* he? And Ziba said unto the king, Behold, he *is* in the house of Machir, the son of Ammiel, in Lodebar.
