THREE MEALS MARK 14:22-26

I. Passover meal: a meal of great deliverance!

<u>Mark 14:22</u> And as they did eat, Jesus took bread, and blessed, and brake *it*, and gave to them, and said, Take, eat: this is my body.

<u>1 Corinthians 5:7</u> Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:

Exodus 12:7 And they shall take of the blood, and strike *it* on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it. Exodus 12:11 And thus shall ye eat it; *with* your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it *is* the LORD'S

passover. Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I *am* the LORD. Exodus 12:13 And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye *are*: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy *you*, when I smite the land of Egypt. Exodus 12:14 And this day shall be unto you for a memorial; and ye shall keep it a feast to the LORD throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance forever.

Exodus 12:17 And ye shall observe *the feast of* unleavened bread; for in this selfsame day have I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt: therefore shall ye observe this day in your generations by an ordinance **forever**.

Exodus 12:24 And ye shall observe this thing for an ordinance to the and to thy sons **forever**. **Exodus 12:25** And it shall come to pass, when ye be come to the land which the LORD will give you, according as he hath promised, that ye shall keep this service. **Exodus 12:26** And it shall come to pass, when your children shall say unto you, What mean ye by this service? **Exodus 12:27** That ye shall say, It *is* the sacrifice of the LORD'S passover, who passed over the houses of the children of Israel in Egypt, when he smote the Egyptians, and delivered our houses. And the people bowed the head and worshipped.

Exodus 20:1 And God spake all these words, saying, **Exodus 20:2** I *am* the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.

<u>Deuteronomy 5:15</u> And remember that thou wast a servant in the land of Egypt, and *that* the LORD thy God brought thee out thence through a mighty hand and by a stretched out arm: therefore the LORD thy God commanded thee to keep the sabbath day.

<u>Deuteronomy 15:15</u> And thou shalt remember that thou wast a bondman in the land of Egypt, and the LORD thy God redeemed thee: therefore I command thee this thing to day.

II. Lord's Supper: a meal of the greatest deliverance!

<u>Mark 14:22</u> And as they did eat, Jesus took bread, and blessed, and brake *it*, and gave to them, and said, Take, eat: this is my body.<u>Mark 14:23</u> And he took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave *it* to them: and they all drank of it.<u>Mark 14:24</u> And he said unto them, This is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many.

<u>1 Corinthians 11:23</u> For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the *same* night in which he was betrayed took bread: **<u>1 Corinthians 11:24</u>** And when he had given thanks, he brake *it*, and said, **Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me. <u>1</u> <u>Corinthians 11:25</u>** After the same manner also *he took* the cup, when he had supped, saying, **This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink** *it*, **in remembrance of me.**

<u>Ephesians 1:7</u> In whom we have redemption **through his blood**, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

<u>Romans 3:24</u> Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:<u>Romans 3:25</u> Whom God hath set forth *to be* a propitiation through faith in his blood.... <u>Colossians 1:12</u> Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: <u>Colossians 1:13</u> Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of his dear Son: <u>Colossians 1:14</u> In whom we have redemption through his blood, *even* the forgiveness of sins:

III. The marriage supper: a meal of final deliverance!

<u>Mark 14:25</u> Verily I say unto you, I will drink <u>no more</u> of the fruit of the vine, **until** that day that I drink it new in the kingdom of God.

<u>Luke 22:16</u> For I say unto you, I will <u>not</u> any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the kingdom of God. <u>Luke 22:17</u> And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide *it* among yourselves: <u>Luke</u> 22:18 For I say unto you, I will <u>not</u> drink of the fruit of the vine, until the kingdom of God shall come. <u>1 Corinthians 11:26</u> For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come.

<u>Revelation 19:1</u> And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God: Revelation 19:2 For true and righteous are his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand. Revelation 19:3 And again they said, Alleluia. And her smoke rose up for ever and ever. Revelation 19:4 And the four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshipped God that sat on the throne, saying, Amen; Alleluia. Revelation 19:5 And a voice came out of the throne, saying, Praise our God, all ye his servants, and ye that fear him, both small and great. Revelation 19:6 And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth. Revelation 19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready. Revelation 19:8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints. Revelation 19:9 And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God. Revelation 21:1 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. Revelation 21:2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. Revelation 21:3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. Revelation 21:4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. Revelation 21:5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. Revelation 21:6 And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely.

<u>Revelation 22:3</u> And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him: **<u>Revelation 22:4</u>** And they shall see his face; and his name *shall be* in their foreheads. **<u>Revelation 22:5</u>** And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever. **<u>Revelation 22:6</u>** And he said unto me, These sayings *are* faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to shew unto his servants the things which must shortly be done.
