Mark 3:19 And Judas Iscariot, which also betrayed him: and they went into an house.

Mark 14:10 And Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve, **went unto** the chief priests, **to betray him** unto them. **Mark 14:11** And when they heard *it*, they were glad, and promised to give him money. And he sought how he might conveniently **betray** him.

Mark 14:17 And in the evening he cometh with the twelve. **Mark 14:18** And as they sat and did eat, Jesus said, Verily I say unto you, One of you which eateth with me shall betray me. **Mark 14:19** And they began to be sorrowful, and to say unto him one by one, *Is it I?* and another said, *Is it I?* **Mark 14:20** And he answered and said unto them, *It is* one of the twelve, that dippeth with me in the dish. **Mark 14:21** The Son of man indeed goeth, as it is written of him: but woe to that man by whom the Son of man is betrayed! good were it for that man if he had never been born.

Mark 14:41 And he cometh the third time, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take *your* rest: it is enough, the hour is come; **behold, the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners.** **Mark 14:42** Rise up, let us go; lo, **he that betrayeth me is at hand.** **Mark 14:43** And immediately, while he yet spake, cometh Judas, one of the twelve, and with him a great multitude with swords and staves, from the chief priests and the scribes and the elders. **Mark 14:44** And **he that betrayed him** had given them a token, saying, Whomsoever I shall kiss, that same is he; take him, and lead *him* away safely. **Mark 14:45** And as soon as he was come, he goeth straightway to him, and saith, Master, master; and kissed him. **Mark 14:46** And they laid their hands on him, and took him.

Mark 15:1 And straightway in the morning the chief priests held a consultation with the elders and scribes and the whole council, and bound Jesus, and carried *him* away, and **delivered him to Pilate.**

Mark 15:10 For he knew that the chief priests **had delivered him for envy.**

Mark 15:15 And *so* Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and **delivered Jesus**, when he had scourged *him*, to be crucified. **Mark 15:16** And the soldiers led him away into the hall, called Praetorium; and they call together the whole band. **Mark 15:17** And they clothed him with purple, and platted a crown of thorns, and put it about his *head*. **Mark 15:18** And began to salute him, Hail, King of the Jews! **Mark 15:19** And they smote him on the head with a reed, and did spit upon him, and bowing *their* knees worshipped

him.**Mark 15:20** And when they had mocked him, they took off the purple from him, and put his own clothes on him, and led him out to crucify him.**Mark 15:21** And they compel one Simon a Cyrenian, who passed by, coming out of the country, the father of Alexander and Rufus, to bear his cross.**Mark 15:22** And they bring him unto the place Golgotha, which is, being interpreted, The place of a skull.
