

THE GENESIS OF JESUS THE MESSIAH

Matthew 1:1 THE book of the generation (Βίβλος γενέσεως Ἰησοῦ χριστοῦ) of Jesus Christ, the son of David (υιοῦ Δαυίδ), the son of Abraham (υιοῦ Ἀβραάμ).

Matthew 1:17 So all the generations from Abraham (ἀπὸ Ἀβραάμ) to David (ἕως Δαυίδ) are fourteen generations; and from David (ἀπὸ Δαυίδ) until the carrying away into Babylon are fourteen generations; and from the carrying away into Babylon unto Christ (ἕως τοῦ χριστοῦ) are fourteen generations.

Matthew 1:18 Now the birth (ἡ γέννησις) of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.

1. That Jesus had a real, human history!

Matthew 1:17 So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations; and from David until the carrying away into Babylon are fourteen generations; and from the carrying away into Babylon unto Christ are fourteen generations.

Hebrews 4:15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; **but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.**

1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. **1 John 4:2** Hereby **know ye the Spirit of God:** Every spirit that confesseth **that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:** **1 John 4:3** And every spirit that confesseth **not** that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is **not** of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

Job 9:32 For he is not a man, as I am, that I should answer him, And we should come together in judgment. **Job 9:33** Neither is there any daysman betwixt us, That might lay his hand upon us both.

2. That Jesus had a complicated history!

Matthew 1:2 Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren; **Matthew 1:3** And Judas begat Phares and Zara **of Thamar**; and Phares begat Esrom; and Esrom begat Aram; **Matthew 1:4** And Aram begat Aminadab; and Aminadab begat Naasson; and Naasson begat Salmon; **Matthew 1:5** And Salmon begat Booz **of Rachab**; and Booz begat Obed **of Ruth**; and Obed begat Jesse; **Matthew 1:6** And Jesse begat David the king; and David the king begat Solomon **of her that had been the wife of Urias**;

Psalms 130:3 If thou, LORD, shouldest mark iniquities, O Lord, **who shall stand?** **Psalms 130:4** **But there is forgiveness with thee, That thou mayest be feared.**

3. That Jesus had an Abrahamic history!

Matthew 1:1 THE book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, **the son of Abraham.**

Matthew 1:17 So all the generations **from Abraham** to David are fourteen generations; and from David until the carrying away into Babylon are fourteen generations; and from the carrying away into Babylon unto Christ are fourteen generations.

Genesis 12:3 And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: **and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.**

Genesis 18:18 Seeing that Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, **and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?**

Genesis 22:18 **And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed;** because thou hast obeyed my voice.

Genesis 26:4 And I will make thy seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto thy seed all these countries; **and in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed;**

Genesis 28:14 And thy seed shall be as the dust of the earth, and thou shalt spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south: **and in thee and in thy seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed.**

Psalms 72:17 His name shall endure for ever: His name shall be continued as long as the sun: **And men shall be blessed in him: All nations shall call him blessed.**

Acts 3:25 Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, **And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed.** **Acts 3:26** Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Jesus, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.

Galatians 3:8 And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, **saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed.**

4. That Jesus had a Davidic history!

Matthew 1:1 THE book of the generation of Jesus Christ, **the son of David**, the son of Abraham.

Matthew 1:17 So all the generations from Abraham to David are fourteen generations; and from David until the carrying away into Babylon are fourteen generations; and from the carrying away into Babylon unto Christ are fourteen generations.

Romans 1:1 PAUL, a servant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated unto the gospel of God, **Romans 1:2** (Which he had promised afore by his prophets in the holy scriptures,) **Romans 1:3** Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, **which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh;** **Romans 1:4** And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead:

Revelation 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: **behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David,** hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

Revelation 22:16 I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. **I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star.**

5. That Jesus might have a saving history!

Matthew 1:21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: **for he shall save his people from their sins.**

Luke 19:10 For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.

John 1:29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, **Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.**

1 Timothy 1:15 This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, **that** Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

1 John 3:5 And ye **know that** he was manifested to take away our sins; **and** in him is no sin.
