2. We all actually have more than one kind of tradition

<u>2 Thessalonians 2:15</u> <u>Therefore</u>, brethren, **stand fast** (στήκετε), and **hold** (κρατεῖτε) the traditions (τὰς παραδόσεις ὰς ἐδιδάχθητε) which ye have been taught, **whether** by word, **or** our epistle.

<u>2 Thessalonians 3:6</u> Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and not after the tradition (κατὰ τὴν παράδοσιν) which he received of us.

Mark 7:1 Then came together unto him the Pharisees, and certain of the scribes, which came from Jerusalem. Mark 7:2 And when they saw some of his disciples eat bread with defiled, that is to say, with unwashen, hands, they found fault. Mark 7:3 For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash their hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders (τὴν παράδοσιν τῶν πρεσβυτέρων). Mark 7:4 And when they come from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, as the washing of cups, and pots, brasen vessels, and of tables. Mark 7:5 Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders (κατὰ τὴν παράδοσιν τῶν πρεσβυτέρων), but eat bread with unwashen hands? Mark 7:6 He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me. Mark 7:7 Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men (ἐντάλματα ἀνθρώπων). Mark 7:8 For laying aside the commandment of God (τὴν ἐντολὴν τοῦ θεοῦ), ye hold the tradition of men (τὴν παράδοσιν τῶν ἀνθρώπων), as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do. Mark 7:9 And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God (τὴν ἐντολὴν τοῦ θεοῦ), that ye may keep your own tradition (τὴν παράδοσιν ὑμῶν).

Before we can even have a discussion concerning tradition, traditions, and traditionalism we **must** <u>define</u> our terms!

2 Thessalonians 3:6 Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and not after the tradition (κατὰ τὴν παράδοσιν) which he received of us.

1 Timothy 4:13 Till I come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.

<u>Galatians 3:28</u> There is <u>neither</u> Jew <u>nor</u> Greek, there is <u>neither</u> bond <u>nor</u> free, there is <u>neither</u> male nor female: <u>for</u> ye are all one in Christ Jesus.

<u>1 Corinthians 12:12</u> For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ. <u>1 Corinthians 12:13 For</u> by **one** Spirit are we all baptized into **one** body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into **one** Spirit.
