ON YOUR KNEES: Keep it simple! EPH. 6:18-19

I like my way of doing it better than your way of not doing it! D. L. Moody

Prayer is both natural and difficult. The difficulties don't come primarily from without <u>but</u> from within...second guessing, doubts, fears, overthinking, reading some book.... We often talk ourselves out of prayer!

Paul: I like my way of praying better than your way of not praying!

1. Pray at all times!

Ephesians 6:18 Praying **always** with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

<u>Psalm 55:17</u> Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I pray, and cry aloud: And he shall hear my voice.

Psalm 119:164 Seven times a day do I praise thee Because of thy righteous judgments.

Daniel 6:10 Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.

You hear something in a sermon or read it in a book \rightarrow maybe trying to encourage you...but you feel trapped!

I actually read a book where a male said he had his life scheduled in minute increments!!!

<u>1 Thessalonians 3:10</u> Night and day praying exceedingly <u>that</u> we might see your face, and might perfect that which is lacking in your faith?

<u>1 Thessalonians 5:17</u> Pray without ceasing.

<u>Romans 12:12</u> Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer; <u>Colossians 4:2</u> Continue in prayer, <u>and</u> watch in the same with thanksgiving;

These are not meant to burdens or traps:

- > There is not a time you cannot pray
- Pick one or two or three or four...
- Get in a rythym

2. Pray with all (kinds of) prayer!

<u>Ephesians 6:18</u> Praying always <u>with</u> **all prayer and supplication in the Spirit**, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

<u>1 Timothy 2:1</u> I exhort therefore, that, first of all, <u>supplications</u>, <u>prayers</u>, <u>intercessions</u>, and <u>giving of</u> <u>thanks</u>, be made **for** all men; <u>1 Timothy 2:2</u> **For** kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.

We are not all the sSome of us are nervous, skittish, second guessers, doubters...

All of us fear doing it wrong or not doing it right

Paul simply says: you cannot pray in a wrong way.

3. Pray with all perseverance / persistence!

Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto **with all perseverance** and supplication for all saints;

<u>Acts 12:5</u> Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made **without ceasing of the church** unto God for him.

<u>Matthew 7:7</u> <u>Ask</u>, and it shall be given you; <u>seek</u>, and ye shall find; <u>knock</u>, and it shall be opened unto you: <u>Matthew 7:8</u> For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

4. Pray for all people!

Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication <u>for</u> all saints; <u>Ephesians 6:19</u> And <u>for</u> me, <u>that</u> utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel,

<u>1 Timothy 2:1</u> I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made <u>for all men</u>; <u>1 Timothy 2:2</u> <u>For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. <u>1 Timothy 2:3</u> For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour;</u>

This leads us to and out of another trap! Can I pray for...? The answer is unreservedly YES!!! Unless the person is dead \rightarrow then there is hope.

<u>Romans 10:1</u> Brethren, my heart's desire <u>and</u> prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be saved.

<u>Proverbs 21:1</u> The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water: He turneth it **whithersoever** he will.

Daniel 6:10 Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.
