Galatians 5:6

For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision;

but faith

which worketh

by love.

Faith – eliminates Legalism

- **Sola gratia: by grace alone**
- **Sola fide: through faith alone**
- **Solus Christus: in Christ alone**

Which worketh (s) – eliminates Liberalism lite

By Love – eliminates Legalism lite

<p><u>Galatians 5:13</u> For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use <u>not</u> liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.</p> <p><u>Galatians 5:14</u> For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.</p> <p><u>Galatians 5:16</u> This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.</p> <p><u>Galatians 5:18</u> But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.</p> <p><u>Galatians 5:25</u> If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.</p>	<p><u>Deuteronomy 5:32</u> Ye shall observe to do therefore as the LORD your God hath commanded you: ye shall not turn aside to the right hand or to the left.</p> <p><u>Deuteronomy 12:32</u> What thing soever I command you, observe to do it: thou shalt not add thereto, nor diminish from it.</p>	<p><u>Galatians 2:16</u> Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.</p> <p><u>Galatians 3:6</u> Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.</p> <p><u>Galatians 3:11</u> But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith.</p> <p><u>Galatians 3:1</u> O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you? <u>Galatians 3:2</u> This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? <u>Galatians 3:3</u> Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh? <u>Galatians 3:4</u> Have ye suffered so many things in vain? if it be yet in vain.</p>
