# PURPOSES OF THE APOSTLES EPH. 2:20; 3:5; 4:11

But what's their <u>purpose(s)</u>? (These are not 3 separate & differing purposes but 3 intertwined / interwoven purposes.

# 1. Evangelizing the world!

Luke 24:44 And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me. Luke 24:45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures, Luke 24:46 And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day: Luke 24:47 And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. Luke 24:48 And ye are witnesses of these things.

<u>Acts 10:39</u> And we are witnesses of all things which he <u>did</u> both in the land of the Jews, and in Jerusalem; whom they slew and hanged on a tree: <u>Acts 10:41 Not</u> to all the people, <u>but</u> unto witnesses chosen before of God, <u>even</u> to us, who did eat and drink with him after he rose from the dead.

<u>Ephesians 4:11</u> And he gave some, <u>apostles</u>; and some, <u>prophets</u>; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; <u>Ephesians 2:20</u> And are built upon the <u>foundation</u> of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone;

<u>Ephesians 3:5</u> Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, <u>as</u> it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit;

<u>Acts 1:1</u> THE former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, <u>Acts 1:2</u> Until the day in which he was taken up, after that <u>he</u> through the <u>Holy Ghost</u> had given commandments unto <u>the apostles</u> whom he had chosen: <u>Acts 1:3</u> To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:

Acts 2:42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.

<u>Acts 10:39</u> And <u>we</u> are witnesses of all things which he did both in the land of the Jews, and in Jerusalem; whom they slew and hanged on a tree: <u>Acts 10:40</u> Him God raised up the third day, and shewed him openly; <u>Acts 10:41</u> <u>Not</u> to all the people, <u>but</u> unto witnesses chosen before of God, even to us, who did eat and drink with him after he rose from the dead. <u>Acts 10:42</u> And he commanded us to preach unto the people, and to testify that it is he which was ordained of God to be the Judge of quick and dead. <u>Acts 10:43</u> To him give all the prophets witness, that through his name whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins.

<u>2 Thessalonians 2:15</u> Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle.

<u>2 Peter 3:1</u> This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in both which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance: <u>2</u> Peter 3:2 That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before <u>by the holy prophets</u>, and of <u>the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour:</u>

**<u>2 Peter 3:14</u>** Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless. **<u>2 Peter 3:15</u>** And account that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you; **<u>2 Peter 3:16</u>** As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction. **<u>2 Peter 3:17</u>** Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own stedfastness. **<u>2 Peter 3:18</u>** But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. - > The Canon was variously **summarized** as:
- A. The Law and the Prohpets

# B. The Law (הּוֹרָה), prophets (נְבִראָים) & the writings (כְּתוּבִים)

<u>Luke 24:25</u> Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken: <u>Luke 24:26</u> Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory? <u>Luke 24:27</u> And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.

<u>John 5:39</u> Search the scriptures (τὰς γραφάς); for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me. <u>2 Timothy 3:15</u> And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures (τὰ ἰερὰ γράμματα), which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. <u>2 Timothy 3:16</u> All scripture (Πᾶσα γραφὴ) is given by inspiration of God (θεόπνευστος), and is profitable (ὡφέλιμος) for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

# Christ confirmed the OT Canon!

# Christ also established the NT Canon!

**John 14:16** And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; **John 14:17** Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

#### John 14:25 These things have I spoken unto you, being yet present with you.

John 14:26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

John 15:26 But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, **he shall testify of me:** John 15:27 And ye <u>also</u> shall bear witness, because ye have been with me from the beginning.

John 16:12 I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now.

<u>John 16:13</u> Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: <u>for</u> he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: <u>and</u> he will shew you things to come. <u>John 16:14</u> He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you.

# > The NT Canon gradually took shape

#### 2 Thessalonians 2:15

Therefore, brethren, stand fast ( $\sigma \tau \eta \kappa \epsilon \tau \epsilon$ ), and hold ( $\kappa \rho \alpha \tau \epsilon \tilde{\tau} \tau \epsilon$ ) the traditions ( $\tau \lambda \varsigma \pi \alpha \rho \alpha \delta \delta \sigma \epsilon \iota \varsigma$ ) which ye have been taught, <u>whether</u> by word ( $\delta \iota \lambda \lambda \delta \gamma \sigma \upsilon$ ), <u>or</u> our epistle ( $\delta \iota' \epsilon \pi \iota \sigma \tau \sigma \lambda \eta \varsigma \eta \mu \omega \nu$ ).

# > The Canon was canonical immediately

#### **Canonical = authoritative, Scripture, the Word of God**

<u>1 Timothy 5:17</u> Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honour, especially they who labour in the word and doctrine. <u>1 Timothy 5:18</u> For the scripture saith, Thou shalt not muzzle the ox that treadeth out the corn. <u>And</u>, The labourer is worthy of his reward (τοῦ μισθοῦ αὐτοῦ).

**Deuteronomy 25:4** Thou shalt not muzzle the ox when he treadeth out the corn.

<u>Luke 10:7</u> And in the same house remain, eating and drinking such things as they give: for the labourer is worthy <u>of his hire ( $\tau o \tilde{v}$ </u> <u> $\mu u \sigma \theta o \tilde{v} \alpha v \sigma \tilde{v}$ </u>. Go not from house to house.

<u>1 Corinthians 14:36</u> What? came the word of God out from you? or came it unto you only? <u>1 Corinthians 14:37</u> If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord. <u>1</u> Corinthians 14:38 But if any man be ignorant, let him be ignorant.

# The NT Canon <u>recognized</u> this canonization process

# > The Church continues with a Canon $\rightarrow$ Bible!

**<u>Revelation 1:1</u>** THE Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John: <u>**Revelation 1:2**</u> Who bare record of the word of God, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he saw. <u>**Revelation 1:3**</u> Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.

Revelation 1:10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,

**<u>Revelation 1:11</u>** Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, **What thou seest**, <u>write in a book</u>, and <u>send it unto</u> the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.

**<u>Revelation 1:19</u>** Write the things which thou hast seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter;

# The Church was always and shall always be a "bookish people!" A people of the Book!!!

<u>Deuteronomy 17:18</u> And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that <u>he shall write</u> him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: <u>Deuteronomy 17:19</u> And it shall be <u>with him</u>, and <u>he shall read therein</u> <u>all the days of his life</u>: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them:

<u>Deuteronomy 31:11</u> When all Israel is come to appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose, thou shalt read this law before all Israel in their hearing.

**Joshua 1:8** This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

<u>Psalm 37:30</u> The mouth of the righteous speaketh wisdom, And his tongue talketh of judgment. <u>Psalm 37:31</u> <u>The law of his God</u> is in his heart; None of his steps shall slide.
