DEALING WITH THE UNWANTED, UNWELCOME, UNINVITED, **UBIQUITIOUS "LIFE-GUEST!" MT. 18:1-14**

So, how does Jesus tell us to answer = deal with this "life-guest?" 1. Be converted and become like a little child!

Matthew 18:1 At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying, Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven? Matthew 18:2 And Jesus called a little child unto him, and set him in the midst of them,

Matthew 18:3 And said, Verily (Äμὴν) I say unto you, **Except** ye be converted (ἐἀν μὴ στραφῆτε), and become as little children, ve shall not (où µì) enter into the kingdom of heaven.

John 3:1 There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews: John 3:2 The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him. John 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again (ἄνωθεν), he cannot see the kingdom of God.

John 3:4 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?

John 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, Verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of (¿٤) water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. John 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again ($\dot{\alpha}v\omega\theta\varepsilon v$).

Excursus on avorev

Words do not have meaning, only potential meaning. Context gives them meaning! Words are like people, they are known by the company they keep.

John 3:31 He that cometh from above ($O \alpha w \Theta \varepsilon v$) is above all: he that is of the earth is earthly, and speaketh of the earth: he that cometh from heaven is above all.

Matthew 27:51 And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top ($\epsilon i \zeta \delta v \phi a \pi \delta a v \phi \theta \epsilon v \epsilon \omega \zeta \kappa \delta \tau \omega$) to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;

Mark 15:38 And the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top ($\epsilon i \zeta \delta v \delta a \pi \delta a v \delta \theta \epsilon v \delta \omega \zeta \kappa \delta \tau \omega$) to the bottom. Luke 1:3 It seemed good to me also, having had perfect understanding of all things from the very first ($\dot{\alpha}v\omega\theta\epsilon v$), to write unto thee in order, most excellent Theophilus,

John 19:11 Jesus answered, Thou couldest have no power at all against me, except it were given thee from above $(\ddot{\alpha}v\omega\theta\varepsilon v)$: therefore he that delivered me unto the hath the greater sin.

John 19:23 Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took his garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also his coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top ($\dot{\alpha}v\omega\theta\varepsilon v$) throughout.

Acts 26:5 Which knew me from the beginning ($\ddot{\alpha}\nu\omega\theta\epsilon\nu$), if they would testify, that after the most straitest sect of our religion I lived a Pharisee.

Galatians 4:9 But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again ($\pi \dot{\alpha} \lambda i v$) to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire **again** ($\pi \dot{\alpha} \lambda \mathbf{i} \mathbf{v} \mathbf{\omega} \boldsymbol{\Theta} \mathbf{\epsilon} \mathbf{v}$) to be in bondage?

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above (ἄνωθέν), and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

James 3:15 This wisdom descendeth not from above ($\delta v \omega \theta \varepsilon v$), but is earthly, sensual, devilish.

James 3:17 But the wisdom that is from above ($\dot{\eta} \sigma \sigma \phi (\alpha \dot{\alpha} v \omega \theta \epsilon v)$) is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.

John 3:14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: John 3:15 That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life. John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever **believeth** in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

2. Humble **vourself** like a little child!

Matthew 18:4 Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

James 4:6 But he give h more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but give h grace unto the humble. James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God...

James 4:10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.

<u>**1** Peter 5:5</u> Likewise, ye younger, <u>**submit**</u> yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you <u>**be subject one to another**</u>, and **be clothed with humility**: <u>**for**</u> God resistent the proud, and giveth grace to the humble. <u>**1** Peter 5:6</u> **Humble yourselves** therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:

<u>Matthew 23:11</u> But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant. <u>Matthew 23:12</u> And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.

Humility has several difficulties:

- > What is it? How does one define it? What does it look like?
- > Why would I want it?
- > How is a child humble? In what way?

Total, complete, absolute, dependence on parents / God!

2 Corinthians 3:5 Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God;

For me, humility is a combination of: C. S. Lewis⁺ Humility is <u>not</u> thinking less of yourself <u>but</u> thinking of yourself less! Plus thinking **most** about God And **much more** about others = little people

Plus submission

Proverbs 18:12 Before destruction the heart of man is haughty, And before honour is humility.

Proverbs 22:4 By humility and the fear of the LORD Are riches, and honour, and life.

Proverbs 29:23 A man's pride shall bring him low: But honour shall uphold the humble in spirit.

Isaiah 57:15 For thus saith the high and lofty One That inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, With him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, To revive the spirit of the humble, And to revive the heart of the contrite ones. **Micah 6:8** He hath shewed thee, O man, what is good; And what doth the LORD require of thee, But to do justly, and to love mercy, And to walk humbly with thy God?

3. Welcoming little children...&/ little ones!

Little ones = insignificant people

<u>Matthew 18:5</u> And whoso <u>shall receive</u> (δέξηται παιδίον τοιοῦτον) one such little child in my name <u>receiveth</u> (ἐμὲ δέχεται) me.

What might this look like?	
Love them	See them
Encourage them	Guide them
Talk with them	Listen to them

4. Never, ever harm little ones!

Little ones =

<u>Matthew 18:6</u> But whoso shall offend one of these little ones (ἕνα τῶν μικρῶν τούτων) which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea. <u>Matthew 18:7</u> Woe unto the world because of offences! for it must needs be that offences come; but woe to that man by whom the offence cometh!

<u>Matthew 18:10</u> Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones ($\dot{\epsilon}v\dot{\delta}\zeta \tau \tilde{\omega}v \mu \kappa \rho \tilde{\omega}v \tau \sigma \dot{\delta}\tau \omega v$); for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of my Father which is in heaven. <u>Matthew 18:11</u> For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost.

<u>Matthew 18:14</u> Even so it is not the will of your Father which is in heaven, that one of these little ones (τῶν μικρῶν τούτων) should perish.
