POST-EVANGELISM

Matthew 28:19-20

Go (Πορευθέντες) ye therefore,

and teach (μαθητεύσατε) all nations,

baptizing (βαπτίζοντες) them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

<u>Teaching (διδάσκοντες)</u> them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

- <u>2 Timothy 2:2</u> And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.
- <u>2 Timothy 3:10</u> But thou hast **fully known** my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, patience, <u>2 Timothy 3:11</u> Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of them all the Lord delivered me.
- 2 Timothy 3:14 But (Σὴ δὲ μένε) continue thou in the things (ἐν οἶς ἔμαθες) which thou hast learned and hast been assured of (καὶ ἐπιστώθης), knowing of whom (παρὰ τίνος ἔμαθες) thou hast learned them;
- 2 Timothy 3:15 And that from a child (ἀπὸ βρέφους) thou hast known the holy scriptures (τὰ ἱερὰ γράμματα), which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. 2 Timothy 3:16 All scripture (Πᾶσα γραφὴ) is given by inspiration of God (θεόπνευστος), and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 2 Timothy 3:17 That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.

"Go" in the Gospel	Gospel to every person & every people group	Gospel into all of life

Discipleship | learning by any other name it still...! Evangelism goes beyond the go, & even the gospel, to the gospel into all of life!

What might this look like?

1. Learning about "some things!"

<u>2 Timothy 2:2</u> And <u>the things (α)</u> that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, <u>the same (ταῦτα)</u> commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.

<u>Acts 2:42</u> And they continued stedfastly **in the apostles' doctrine** and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.

<u>2 Timothy 1:13</u> Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in Christ Jesus.

Jude 3 Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints (τῆ ἄπαξ παραδοθείση τοῖς ἀγίοις πίστει).

Ephesians 4:4 There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; Ephesians 4:5 One Lord, one faith, one baptism, Ephesians 4:6 One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

Acts 20:27 For I have not shunned to declare unto you all the counsel of God.


<u>Galatians 1:23</u> But they had heard only, That he which persecuted us in times past now preacheth <u>the faith</u> which once he destroyed.

<u>2 Timothy 4:3</u> For the time will come when they will not endure **sound doctrine**; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;

What might this be called / how might this be described?

- > The same things that we have learned
- > The faith ...once delivered to the saints
- > Apostolic teaching
- > The whole counsel of God
- > Sound / healthy doctrine

In summary:



2. Learning from someone(s):

<u>2 Timothy 2:2</u> And the things that thou hast heard <u>of me (παρ' ἐμοῦ)</u> among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.

<u>2 Timothy 3:10</u> But thou hast fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, patience, <u>2 Timothy 3:11</u> Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of them all the Lord delivered me.

2 Timothy 3:14 But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, **knowing of** whom (είδως παρὰ τίνος) thou hast learned them;

Nothing weird here! No new denominations...however:

- > παρά not just άπό
- So alongside of Paul <u>not</u> just from Paul!
- > Classroom and life
- > In / at church and at lunch
- > Theory and practice
- ➤ Heard & observed
- ➤ Learned & lived

I do We do You do

3. Learning in public

<u>2 Timothy 2:2</u> And the things that thou hast heard of me among <u>many</u> witnesses (διὰ <u>πολλῶν</u> μαρτύρων), the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.

This text is often misquoted / misapplied as teaching one-on-one discipleship only!

One-on-one discipleship is certainly fine but this text focusses more on:

- Local church discipleship
- ➤ And **no** hidden, secret doctrines / teachings → reserved for the enlightened or initiated.

<u>John 18:19</u> The high priest then asked Jesus of his disciples, <u>and</u> of his doctrine. <u>John 18:20</u> Jesus answered him, I spake openly to the world; I ever taught in the synagogue, and in the temple, whither the Jews always resort; and in secret have I said <u>nothing</u>.

<u>Matthew 4:23</u> And Jesus went about all Galilee, <u>teaching</u> in their synagogues, and <u>preaching</u> the gospel of the kingdom, and <u>healing</u> all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.

<u>Matthew 9:35</u> And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, <u>teaching</u> in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

Acts 20:20 And how I kept back nothing that was profitable unto you, but have shewed you, and have taught you publickly, and from house to house,

Acts 26:26 For the king knoweth of these things, before whom also I speak freely: for I am persuaded that none of these things are hidden from him; for this thing was <u>not</u> done in a corner.

4. Learning by many means!

Galatians 6:6 Let <u>him that is taught (ὁ κατηχούμενος)</u> in the word **communicate (Κοινωνείτω)** unto <u>him that teacheth (τῷ κατηχοῦντι)</u> in all good things.

Acts 17:17 Therefore disputed he <u>in the synagogue (ἐν τῆ συναγωγῆ</u> τοῖς Ἰουδαίοις καὶ τοῖς σεβομένοις) with the Jews, and with the devout persons, and <u>in the market (ἐν τῆ ἀγορᾶ)</u> daily with them that met with him.

Acts 28:23 And when they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into his lodging; to whom he **expounded** and **testified** the kingdom of God, **persuading** them concerning Jesus, both out of the law of Moses, and out of the prophets, from morning till evening. Acts 28:24 And **some** believed the things which were spoken, **and some** believed not. Acts 28:31 Preaching the kingdom of God, and **teaching** those things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ, with all confidence, no man forbidding him.

5. Learning to live!

Ezra 7:10 For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the law of the LORD, and to do it, and to teach in Israel statutes and judgments.

6. Learning for reinvestment (in others)

<u>2 Timothy 2:2</u> And the things that <u>thou</u> hast **heard of <u>me</u>** among many witnesses, the same commit thou **to faithful men**, who shall be able to teach **others also**.

Me = Paul, thou = Timothy, faithful men → others also!

This leaves us with one question: **How** will I reinvest? What form will my reinvestment take?
