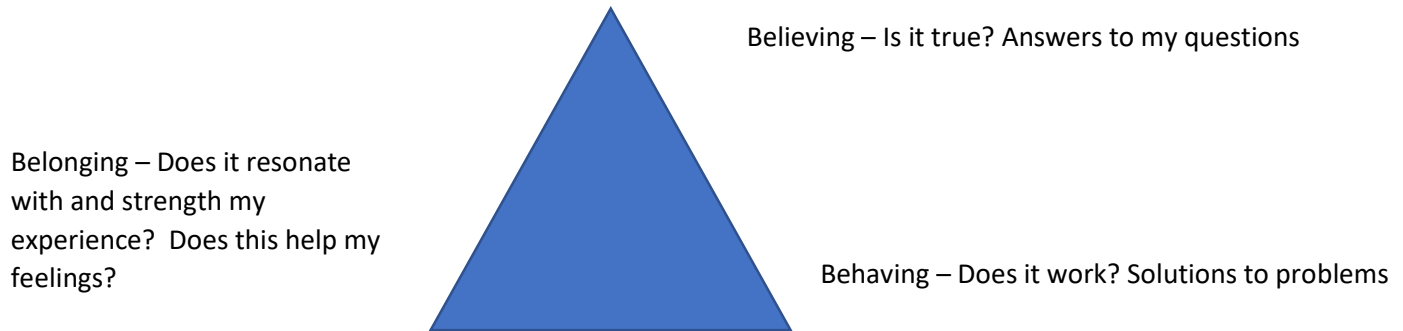


# BASICS OF APOLOGETICS IN THE NT

**1 Timothy 1:4** Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do.

**1 Timothy 6:20** O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called:

**2 Timothy 2:16** But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness.

**2 Timothy 2:23** But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.

**Titus 1:14** Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, that turn from the truth.

**Titus 3:9** But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.
