## **Broad options:**

### 1. All is nature & nature is all

Naturalistic evolution is obvious in the west.

Evolution is highly varied and frankly confusing.

Most (almost all) of evolution is merely a way of kicking the can down the road.

Focusing on the evolution of many specifics including man...but not the real origins of life<sup>+++</sup>.

Macro - evolution: change from species to species

Micro - "evolution:" change within species

#### **Evolution has so many issues:**

- > Something comes from nothing / nothing produce something
- > The person / the individual cannot really be explained
- > Can we live with this view of humanity?

## 2. All is "god" & "god" is all

This is most common in Hinduisms & Buddisms

#### **Thoughts:**

- > "god" is <u>not</u> personal &/ can<u>not</u> be known → so "god" is used as a mere cipher but without much meaning.
- > Creation is "part of" / an "extension of" / a "manifestation of" god
- > Creation can also be an illusion and not reality
- > The goal of life is to get back to God / be one with God
- 3. God created the world but God is <u>not</u> the world and the world is <u>not</u> God!
