## **BIBLICAL CREATION**

What does this mean and teach? God as Creator AND Maker:

> God created the elements

בָּרֵאשִׁית בַּרָא אֵלֹהָים אֵת הַשַּׁמַיִם וְאֵת הָאַרֵץ:

<u>Genesis 1:1</u> In the beginning God created (בָּרֵא) **the heaven and the earth**. <u>Genesis 1:2</u> And the earth was without **form, and void;** and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

At the most basic level all things are made up of these elements  $\rightarrow$  the dust/earth

We might call this: Chemistry

Create (X)2): is used only of God and used only for creation Ex Nihilo

God also makes/forms → Ex Materia from what he created

Genesis 1:21 And God created (נִיבְרֵא) great whales, and every living creature that moveth, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that it was good.

<u>Genesis 1:27</u> So God created (נֵיִּבְרָא) man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

<u>Genesis 2:3</u> And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created (אַשֶׁר־בַּרֵא אֱלֹהִים לְעֵשִׂוֹת) and made.

## God created the principle of life / life itself

<u>Genesis 1:21</u> And God created (וַיִּבְרֵא) great whales, and every living (בֶּל־תֵבֶּשׁ) creature that moveth (הַתַּיֵּהוּ), which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, and every winged fowl after his kind: and God saw that it was good.

**Example** from my work experience: canine, bovine, equine, feline...

We might call this: Biology & Zoology

## > God created the Imago Dei in man!

Genesis 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. Genesis 1:27 So God created (וַיִּבְרָא אֱלֹהֶיםׁ וְאֶת־הָאָדָם) man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. Genesis 1:28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

This was BOTH created AND made.

We might call this: anthropology

➤ God made all – male and female – in His image → the Imago Dei

Structural: who we are

Relational: to God and people

**Functional:** have dominion

Broadly this would include elements of basic rationality:

<u>Luke 1:35</u> And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God. <u>Luke 1:36</u> And, behold, thy cousin Elisabeth, she hath also conceived a son <u>in her old age</u>: and this is the sixth month with her, who was called barren. <u>Luke 1:37</u> For with God nothing shall be impossible. <u>Luke 1:38</u> And Mary said, Behold the handmaid of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy word. And the angel departed from her.

The law of non-contradiction: a cannot be a and non-a at the same and in the same

The law of basic reliability of sense perception
