Romans 3:28			

Romans 3:28 Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.

Romans 4:1-5			

Romans 4:1 What shall we say then that Abraham our father, as pertaining to the flesh, hath found?

Romans 4:2 For **if** Abraham were justified by works, he hath whereof to glory; but not before God.

Romans 4:3 **For what saith the scripture?** Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.

Romans 4:4 Now to him that worketh is the reward **not** reckoned of grace, **but** of debt.

Romans 4:5 But to him that worketh **not**, **but** **believeth on him** that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.

How did the OT saints know about the Messiah?

Genesis 12:3 And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: **and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.**

Genesis 18:18 Seeing that Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, **and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?**

Genesis 22:18 **And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed;** because thou hast obeyed my voice.

How did the OT saints know about the Messiah?

Genesis 26:4 And I will make thy seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto thy seed all these countries; **and in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed;**

Genesis 28:14 And thy seed shall be as the dust of the earth, and thou shalt spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south: **and in thee and in thy seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed.**

How did the OT saints know about the Messiah?

Genesis 49:10 The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, Nor a lawgiver from between his feet, Until Shiloh come; And unto him shall the gathering of the people be.

Deuteronomy 18:15 The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, **like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;**

How did the OT saints know about the Messiah?

Acts 3:22 For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you. **Acts 3:23** And it shall come to pass, that every soul, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people.

Acts 7:37 This is that Moses, which said unto the children of Israel, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear.

How did the OT saints know about the Messiah?

John 8:56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad.

John 8:57 Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham?

John 8:58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.

How did the OT saints know about the Messiah?

Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, And shall call his name Immanuel.

Jeremiah 23:5 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

How did the OT saints know about the Messiah?

Micah 5:2 But thou, Beth-lehem Ephratah, Though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, Yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; Whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

Matthew 1:1 THE book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham.

Romans 4:6-8			

Romans 4:6 **Even as** David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputeth righteousness **without** works,

Romans 4:7 Saying, Blessed are they whose iniquities are **forgiven**, and whose sins **are covered**.

Romans 4:8 Blessed is the man to whom the Lord will **not** impute sin.

Galatians 2:16			

Galatians 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

Galatians 3:8 And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed.

Galatians 3:11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith.
