Psalm 128 & Psalm 129 go tother! They must be held together, and even sung together!

129:1-3: Cantor / Reader / Leader 129:4: response of Congregation

129:5-8 : Unison

1. A Call to Remember / Rehearse!

<u>Psalm 129:1</u> Many a time have they afflicted me from my youth, May Israel now say:

<u>Psalm 129:2</u> Many a time have they afflicted me from my youth: Yet they have not prevailed against me. <u>Psalm 129:3</u> The plowers plowed upon my back: They made long their furrows.

The Cantor begins by rehearing what Israel can say:

➤ We have been afflicted

Suffered, attacked, distressed...

➤ We have been afflicted many times & in many ways

Many a time (רַבַּת) = both number & magnitude

➤ We have been afflicted **from** our youth – since the beginning of the nation

Exodus 1:11 Therefore they did set over them taskmasters to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses. Exodus 1:12 But the more they afflicted them, the more they multiplied and grew. And they were grieved because of the children of Israel. Exodus 1:13 And the Egyptians made the children of Israel to serve with rigour: Exodus 1:14 And they made their lives bitter with hard bondage, in morter, and in brick, and in all manner of service in the field: all their service, wherein they made them serve, was with rigour.

Exodus 2:22 And she bare him a son, and he called his name Gershom: for he said, I have been a stranger in a strange land. Exodus 2:23 And it came to pass in process of time, that the king of Egypt died: and the children of Israel sighed by reason of the bondage, and they cried, and their cry came up unto God by reason of the bondage. Exodus 2:24 And God heard their groaning, and God remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob. Exodus 2:25 And God looked upon the children of Israel, and God had respect unto them.

> We have been afflicted seriously, ruthlessly, & cruelly!

Psalm 129:3 The plowers plowed upon my back: They made long their furrows.

<u>Micah 3:12</u> Therefore shall Zion for your sake be plowed as a field, And Jerusalem shall become heaps, And the mountain of the house as the high places of the forest.

> We have been afflicted irrationally

Psalm 129:5 Let them all be confounded and turned back That hate Zion.

<u>John 15:18</u> <u>If</u> the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before it hated you. <u>John 15:19</u> <u>If</u> ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, **therefore** the world hateth you. <u>John 15:20</u> Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. <u>If</u> they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; <u>if</u> they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also. <u>John 15:21</u> But all these things will they do unto you for my name's sake, because they know not him that sent me.

<u>John 16:33</u> These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

<u>Philippians 1:29</u> For unto you **it is given** in the behalf of Christ, <u>not only</u> to believe on him, <u>but also</u> to suffer for his sake;

Acts 14:22 Confirming the souls of the disciples, and exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God.

➤ We have been afflicted **but...**not too much | not beyond help!!!

Psalm 129:2 Many a time have they afflicted me from my youth: Yet they have not prevailed against me.

<u>1 Corinthians 10:13</u> There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will <u>not</u> suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.

<u>Psalm 37:23</u> The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: And he delighteth in his way. <u>Psalm 37:24</u> **Though he fall**, he shall <u>not</u> be utterly cast down: <u>For</u> the LORD upholdeth him with his hand.

<u>Proverbs 24:16</u> For a just man falleth seven times, and riseth up again: But the wicked shall fall into mischief. <u>Proverbs 24:17</u> Rejoice not when thine enemy falleth, And let not thine heart be glad when he stumbleth:

2. A Response of Faith & Confidence!

<u>Psalm 129:4</u> **The LORD is righteous**: He hath cut asunder the cords of the wicked. Righteous = just, right, righteous!

In the middle of a raging flood – believers have a place to stand!

Genesis 18:25 That be far from thee to do after this manner, to slay the righteous with the wicked: and that the righteous should be as the wicked, that be far from thee: Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?

Psalm 103:19 The LORD hath prepared his throne in the heavens; And his kingdom ruleth over all.

<u>1 Samuel 17:45</u> Then said David to the Philistine, <u>Thou</u> comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: <u>but</u> I come to thee in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied.

<u>Daniel 3:16</u> Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we are not careful to answer thee in this matter. <u>Daniel 3:17</u> If it be so, **our God whom we serve is able** to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of thine hand, O king. <u>Daniel 3:18</u> But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

<u>Job 19:25</u> For I know that my redeemer liveth, And that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth: <u>Job 19:26</u> And though after my skin worms destroy this body, Yet in my flesh shall I see God: <u>Job 19:27</u> Whom I shall see for myself, And mine eyes shall behold, and not another; Though my reins be consumed within me.

<u>Job 23:10</u> But he knoweth the way that I take: When he hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold.

<u>Revelation 11:15</u> And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, **The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.**

3. A Prayer for a Just Intervention!

<u>Psalm 129:8</u> <u>Neither</u> do they which go by say, The blessing of the LORD be upon you: We bless you in the name of the LORD.
