IS THERE REALLY FORGIVENESS?

Acts 13:38 Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: Acts 13:39 And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.

Paul's message answers some of the basic questions that we all have:

- ➤ What is forgiveness? What does it look like?
- > Can / does God forgive any &/ all sins?
- > Can / does God forgive... every person?
- ➤ **How** | **where** do we find forgiveness?

What was the Apostle Paul proclaiming?

1. There is forgiveness!

There are many ways of explaining & illustrating what forgiveness looks like:

Acts 13:38 Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness (ἄφεσις ἀμαρτιῶν) of sins: Acts 13:39 And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.

To clease us!

1 John 1:9 If we confess (ὁμολογῶμεν) our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive (ἀφ \mathfrak{H}) us our sins, and to cleanse (καθαρίση) us from all unrighteousness.

To send sin away!

Matthew 13:36 Then Jesus sent (ἀφεὶς τοὺς ὅχλους) the multitude away, and went into the house: and his disciples came unto him, saying, Declare unto us the parable of the tares of the field.

Mark 4:36 And when they had sent away (ἀφέντες τὸν ὅχλον) the multitude, they took him even as he was in the ship. And there were also with him other little ships.

<u>Job 7:21</u> And why dost thou not pardon my transgression, And take away mine iniquity? For now shall I sleep in the dust; And thou shalt seek me in the morning, but I shall not be.

To freely forgive!

Ephesians 4:32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving (χαριζόμενοι) one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven (ἐχαρίσατο) you.

Romans 8:32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give (γαρίσεται) us all things?

To cover it!

Psalm 85:2 Thou hast forgiven the iniquity of thy people, Thou hast covered all their sin. Selah.

To blot it out!

<u>Isaiah 43:25</u> I, even I, am he **that blotteth out** thy transgressions for mine own sake, And will not remember thy sins.

To cast it into the depths of the sea *******!

Micah 7:18 Who is a God like unto thee, that <u>pardoneth</u> iniquity, And <u>passeth by</u> the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? He retaineth <u>not</u> his anger for ever, Because he <u>delighteth</u> in mercy. <u>Micah 7:19</u> He will <u>turn again</u>, he <u>will have compassion</u> upon us; He will <u>subdue</u> our iniquities; **And thou wilt east all their sins into the depths of the sea.**

To remove it as far as...!

Psalm 103:12 As far as the east is from the west, So far hath he removed our transgressions from us.

To cast it behind His back!

<u>Isaiah 38:17</u> Behold, for peace I had great bitterness: But thou hast in love to my soul delivered it from the pit of corruption: For thou hast east all my sins behind thy back.

2. Forgiveness for all sins!

Acts 13:38 Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: Acts 13:39 And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.

3. Forgiveness for all who believe!

Acts 13:38 Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: Acts 13:39 And by him all that believe ($\pi \tilde{\omega} c$ ὁ $\pi \iota \sigma \tau \epsilon \dot{\omega} \omega v$) are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.

4. Forgiveness through **THIS** man...& <u>none</u> other!

Acts 13:38 Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this (ὅτι διὰ τούτου) man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: Acts 13:39 And by him (ἐν τούτω) all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.

Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission (ἄφεσιν ἀμαρτιῶν) of sins...

Acts 5:31 Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness (ἄφεσιν ἀμαρτιῶν) of sins.

Acts 10:43 To him give all the prophets witness, that through his name **whosoever** believeth in him shall receive remission (ἄφεσιν ὑμαρτιῶν) of sins.

Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

<u>John 3:16</u> For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

Romans 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

<u>Isaiah 53:6</u> <u>All</u> we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned every one to his own way; And the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us <u>all</u>.

<u>1 Peter 3:18</u> For Christ also hath **once suffered** for sins, the just <u>for</u> the unjust, <u>that</u> he might bring us to God....
