Hebrews 11:13 These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. **1 Peter 2:11** Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul;

<u>Psalm 120:title</u> A Song of degree<u>s</u>. <u>Psalm 134:title</u> A Song of degree<u>s</u>.

All 15 of the Pilgrim Psalms begin with the same words!

<u>Luke 2:42</u> And when he was twelve years old, **they went <u>up to</u> Jerusalem** after the custom of the feast. <u>Luke 9:51</u> And it came to pass, when the time was come that he should be received **up**, he stedfastly set his face **to go to Jerusalem**,

<u>Luke 18:31</u> Then he took unto him the twelve, and said unto them, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of man shall be accomplished. <u>Luke 19:28</u> And when he had thus spoken, he went before, **ascending up to Jerusalem**.

<u>Psalm 133:1</u> Behold, how good and how pleasant it is For brethren to dwell together in unity!
<u>Psalm 133:2</u> It is like the precious ointment upon the head, That ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: That went down to the skirts of his garments; <u>Psalm 133:3</u> As the dew of Hermon, and as the dew that descended upon the mountains of Zion: For there the LORD commanded the blessing, Even life for evermore.

Luke 2:41 Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the passover. Luke 2:42 And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the feast. Luke 2:43 And when they had fulfilled the days, as they returned, the child Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem; and Joseph and his mother knew not of it. Luke 2:44 But they, supposing him to have been in the company (ἐν τῆ συνοδία), went a day's journey; and they sought him among their kinsfolk (ἐν τοῖς συγγενέσιν) and acquaintance (ἐν τοῖς γνωστοῖς).
