Revelation 5:9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast <u>redeemed</u> us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; <u>Revelation 5:10</u> And hast <u>made</u> <u>us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth. <u>Revelation 5:11</u> And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands;</u>

<u>Hebrews 1:10</u> And, Thou, Lord, in the beginning hast laid the foundation of the earth; and the heavens are the works of thine hands: <u>Hebrews 1:11</u> They shall perish; <u>but</u> thou remainest; <u>and</u> they all shall wax old as doth a garment; <u>Hebrews 1:12</u> <u>And</u> as a vesture shalt thou fold them up, and they shall be changed: but **thou art the same**, and thy years shall not fail.

- 2 Timothy 4:1 I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom; 2 Timothy 4:2 Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.

<u>Isaiah 9:6</u> For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: And the government shall be upon his shoulder: And his name shall be called Wonderful, Counseller, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace (שֵׁר־שֶׁלְוֹם). <u>Isaiah 9:7</u> Of the increase of

his government and peace (וּלְשָׁלְוֹם) there shall be no end, Upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, To order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice From henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Revelation 21:4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away. Revelation 21:5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. Revelation 21:6 And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely.

Revelation 22:1 And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. Revelation 22:2 In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. <u>1 Thessalonians 4:13</u> But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. <u>1 Thessalonians 4:14</u> For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. <u>1 Thessalonians 4:15</u> For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. <u>1 Thessalonians 4:16</u> For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: <u>1</u> Thessalonians 4:17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. <u>1 Thessalonians 4:18</u> Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

> An embodied existence!

<u>1 Corinthians 15:12</u> Now if Christ be preached that he rose from the dead, **how say some among you that there is no resurrection of the dead? <u>1 Corinthians 15:13</u> But if there be no resurrection of the dead, then is Christ not risen: <u>1 Corinthians 15:14</u> And if Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain. <u>1 Corinthians 15:15</u> Yea, and we are found false witnesses**

of God; because we have testified of God that he raised up Christ: whom he raised not up, if so be that the dead rise not. <u>1</u> <u>Corinthians 15:16</u> For if the dead rise not, then is not Christ raised: <u>1 Corinthians 15:17</u> And if Christ be not raised, your faith is vain; ye are yet in your sins. <u>1 Corinthians 15:18</u> Then they also which are fallen asleep in Christ are perished. <u>1 Corinthians 15:19</u> If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable.

1 Corinthians 15:20 But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept.

1 Corinthians 15:35 But some man will say, **How** are the dead raised up? and with what body do they come?
