### CONCERNING THE SHEPHERD & THE SHEEP

Psalm 23:1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

Psalm 23:2 He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: He leadeth me beside the still waters.

Psalm 23:3 He restoreth my soul: He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

<u>Psalm 23:4</u> Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; Thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.

Psalm 23:5 Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: Thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.

<u>Psalm 23:6</u> Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: And I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.

#### What do we find in Psalm 23?

#### 1. We are sheep!

#### The Lord often alludes to us as...sheep! Obviously, a shepherd shepherds s

Psalm 74:1 O God, why hast thou cast us off for ever? Why doth thine anger smoke against the sheep of thy pasture?

Psalm 78:52 But made his own people to go forth like sheep, And guided them in the wilderness like a flock.

<u>Psalm 79:13</u> So we thy people and sheep of thy pasture Will give thee thanks for ever: We will shew forth thy praise to all generations.

<u>Psalm 95:7</u> For he is our God; And we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. To day if ye will hear his voice, <u>Psalm 100:3</u> Know ye that the LORD he is God: It is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; We are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

<u>Isaiah 53:6</u> All we **like sheep** have gone astray; We have turned every one to his own way; And the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. <u>Isaiah 53:7</u> He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, Yet he opened not his mouth: He is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, So he openeth not his mouth.

<u>Ezekiel 34:6</u> My sheep wandered through all the mountains, and upon every high hill: yea, my flock was scattered upon all the face of the earth, and none did search or seek after them.

Ezekiel 34:11 For thus saith the Lord GoD; Behold, I, even I, will both search my sheep, and seek them out.

Ezekiel 34:12 As a shepherd seeketh out his flock in the day that he is among his sheep that are scattered; so will I seek out my sheep, and will deliver them out of all places where they have been scattered in the cloudy and dark day.

## 2. And sheep are...sheepish!

We are mostly city people in the USA and have long lost close contact with animals.

#### Sheep are:

- > Dumb / dense
- > Defenseless!
- ➤ Sheep (singular) are sheep (plural) → herd-minded & tend to follow
- Directionally challenged
- > Sheep can't get up without help

Similar to a turtle or a coakroach

Old English "cast down" → means sheep & people

> Easily deceived...confused...fooled!

## 3. Sheep are **NOT** non-sheep!

This cuts both ways!

We are not:		
Dogs	pigs	
Goats	serpents	

Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.

<u>2 Peter 2:22</u> But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, <u>The dog</u> is turned to his own vomit again; and <u>the sow</u> that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.

<u>Matthew 25:31</u> When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: <u>Matthew 25:32</u> And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, **as a shepherd** divideth his sheep from the goats: <u>Matthew 25:33</u> And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, <u>but</u> the goats on the left.

Deuteronomy 23:17 There shall be <u>no</u> whore (קַלֵּקָב) of the daughters of Israel, nor a <u>sodomite (שֵׁלָב)</u> of the sons of Israel. <u>Deuteronomy 23:18</u> Thou shalt not bring the hire of a <u>whore (קַלָּבָל)</u>, or the price of a <u>dog</u> (בַּלָב), into the house of the LORD thy God for any vow: for even both these are abomination unto the LORD thy God.

Revelation 22:14 Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city. Revelation 22:15 For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie.

# 4. We are sheep in need of a shepherd!

<u>Numbers 27:17</u> Which may go out before them, and which may go in before them, and which may lead them out, and which may bring them in; that the congregation of the LORD be not as sheep which have no shepherd.

<u>1 Kings 22:17</u> And he said, I saw all Israel scattered upon the hills, as sheep that have not a shepherd: and the LORD said, These have no master: let them return every man to his house in peace.

Ezekiel 34:12 As a shepherd seeketh out his flock in the day that he is among his sheep that are scattered; so will I seek out my sheep, and will deliver them out of all places where they have been scattered in the cloudy and dark day.

Zechariah 13:7 Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, and against the man that is my fellow, Saith the LORD of hosts: Smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered: And I will turn mine hand upon the little ones.

<u>Matthew 9:36</u> But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, <u>because</u> they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

John 10:11 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

<u>John 10:12</u> But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and the wolf catcheth them, **and scattereth the sheep.** 

John 10:14 I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine.

1 Peter 2:25 For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.

<u>Isaiah 40:11</u> He shall feed his flock like a shepherd: He shall gather the lambs with his arm, And carry them in his bosom, And shall gently lead those that are with young.

Psalm 23:1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:
