#### WHERE IS THE LORD/SHEPHERD WHEN YOU NEED HIM???

### 1. He is **out in front** $\rightarrow$ leading us!

<u>Psalm 23:1</u> The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. <u>Psalm 23:2</u> He **maketh** me to lie down in green pastures: He **leadeth** me beside the still waters. <u>Psalm 23:3</u> He **restoreth** my soul: He **leadeth** me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

<u>John 10:1</u> Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that entereth not by the door into the sheepfold, but climbeth up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber. <u>John 10:2</u> But he that entereth in by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. <u>John 10:3</u> To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and <u>he calleth</u> his own sheep by name, <u>and leadeth</u> them **out**. <u>John 10:4</u> And <u>when</u> he putteth forth his own sheep, **he goeth before them**, and the sheep follow him: <u>for</u> they know his voice. <u>John 10:5</u> And a stranger will they <u>not</u> follow, but will flee from him: for they know <u>not</u> the voice of strangers.

<u>Psalm 78:52</u> But made his own people to go forth like sheep, And guided them in the wilderness like a flock.

<u>Revelation 7:17</u> For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.

<u>John 12:26</u> If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour.

<u>Numbers 27:16</u> Let the LORD, the God of the spirits of all flesh, set a man over the congregation, <u>Numbers 27:17</u> Which may **go out before them**, and which may **go in before them**, and which **may lead them out**, and which **may bring them in**; that the congregation of the LORD be not as sheep which have no shepherd.

<u>Deuteronomy 1:30</u> The LORD your God which goeth before you, he shall fight for you, according to all that he did for you in Egypt before your eyes;

<u>Joshua 3:11</u> Behold, the ark of the covenant of the Lord of all the earth **passeth over before you into Jordan.** 

<u>Ezekiel 46:10</u> And the prince in the midst of them, when they go in, shall go in; and when they go forth, shall go forth.

<u>1 Corinthians 11:1</u> Be ye followers of me, **even as** I also am of Christ.

# 2. He is **right behind us** (bringing up the rear) → following | pursuing us!

<u>Psalm 23:6</u> Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: And I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.

#### We are confronted by two issues:

A. 2 abstract nouns (goodness & mercy) → how do they follow us? Goodness & mercy are **personifications** of the Lord | shepherd

**Exodus 34:6** And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, **Exodus 34:7** Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation.

1 God moves in a mysterious way His wonders to perform; He plants His footsteps in the sea and rides upon the storm.

2 Deep in unfathomable mines of never-failing skill; He treasures up His bright designs, and works His sov'reign will.

3 Ye fearful saints, fresh courage take; the clouds ye so much dread are big with mercy and shall break in blessings on your head.

4 Judge not the Lord by feeble sense, but trust Him for His grace; behind a frowning providence He hides a smiling face.

5 His purposes will ripen fast, unfolding every hour; the bud may have a bitter taste, but sweet will be the flow'r.

6 Blind unbelief is sure to err, and scan His work in vain; God is His own interpreter, and He will make it plain.

## 3. He is with us → defending | restoring | comforting us!

<u>Psalm 23:4</u> Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: **for thou art** with me; Thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.

<u>Joshua 1:5</u> There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

<u>Joshua 1:6</u> Be strong and of a good courage: for unto this people shalt thou divide for an inheritance the land, which I sware unto their fathers to give them.

<u>Joshua 1:7</u> Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest.

<u>Joshua 1:8</u> This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

<u>Joshua 1:9</u> Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.

<u>Isaiah 41:10</u> Fear thou not; for I am with thee: Be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; Yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

<u>John 14:16</u> And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; <u>John 14:17</u> Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. <u>John 14:18</u> I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.
