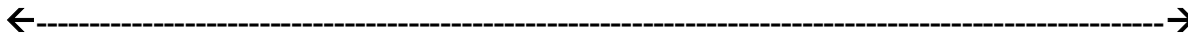


HEALING & HEALTH PS. 103:3B

Psalm 103:3 Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; **Who health (קָרַפָּא) all thy diseases;**

Exodus 15:26 And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for **I am the LORD that healeth thee (אֲנִי יְהוָה רֹפֵאֲךָ).**



There is a **spectrum / continuum of viewpoints or ideas:**

- God always heals!
- God always heals... **IF** we have enough faith, good/give enough, claim it, command it in the name of Jesus, sow our seed (enough)...
- God usually/normally heals
- God sometimes heals
- God healed in the first century / age of the apostles → **not** now/today
- This text isn't talking about healing **but** spiritual healing!
- Healing isn't in the atonement

Thoughts:

1. God can heal all diseases!

Psalm 103:3 Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; **Who health (קָרַפָּא) all thy diseases;**

Exodus 15:26 And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for **I am the LORD that healeth thee (אֲנִי יְהוָה רֹפֵאֲךָ).**

Psalm 103:19 The LORD hath prepared his throne in the heavens; And his kingdom ruleth over all.

Acts 17:24 God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands; **Acts 17:25** Neither is worshipped with men's hands, as though he needed any thing, **seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things;**

Acts 17:28 For in him we **live, and move, and have our being;** as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring.

God is... God!

God is the creator

God is sovereign.

God can!

Psalm 78:19 Yea, they spake against God; they said, **Can God furnish a table in the wilderness?**

2. God has healed all diseases!

Genesis 5:21 And Enoch lived sixty and five years, and begat Methuselah:

Genesis 5:22 And Enoch walked with God after he begat Methuselah three hundred years, and begat sons and daughters: **Genesis 5:23** And all the days of Enoch were three hundred sixty and five years: **Genesis 5:24** **And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him.**

2 Kings 2:11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and **Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.**

2 Kings 4:32 And when Elisha was come into the house, **behold, the child was dead,** and laid upon his bed. **2 Kings 4:33** He went in therefore, and shut the door upon them twain, and prayed unto the LORD. **2 Kings 4:34** And he went up, and lay upon the child, and

put his mouth upon his mouth, and his eyes upon his eyes, and his hands upon his hands: and he stretched himself upon the child; and the flesh of the child waxed warm. **2 Kings 4:35** Then he returned, and walked in the house to and fro; and went up, and stretched himself upon him: and the child sneezed seven times, **and the child opened his eyes.**

John 11:14 Then said Jesus unto them plainly, **Lazarus is dead. John 11:15 And I am glad** for your sakes that I was not there, to the intent ye may believe; nevertheless let us go unto him.

John 11:25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

John 11:26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?

John 11:41 Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up his eyes, and said, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me. **John 11:42** And I knew that thou hearest me always: but because of the people which stand by I said it, that they may believe that thou hast sent me. **John 11:43** And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth. **John 11:44** And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.

3. God will heal all diseases → eventually / in the future!

1 Corinthians 15:20 But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept. **1 Corinthians 15:21** For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead. **1 Corinthians 15:22** For as **in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.**

1 Corinthians 15:35 But some man will say, How are the dead raised up? and with what body do they come?

1 John 3:1 Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not. **1 John 3:2** Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, **we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.**

1 John 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

**The Hope of the Resurrection is part of our metanarrative / big story / good news...which implies:
All die**

Most die of diseases

Some die of traumatic events

5. God & ONLY God heals!

Acts 17:24 God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands; **Acts 17:25** Neither is worshipped with men's hands, as though he needed any thing, **seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things;**

Acts 17:28 For in him we live, and move, and have our being...

Colossians 1:16 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: **Colossians 1:17** And he is before all things, **and by him all things consist.**

Matthew 4:23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, **teaching** in their synagogues, and **preaching** the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing all** manner of sickness and **all** manner of disease among the people. **Matthew 4:24** And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them. **Matthew 4:25** And there followed him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and from Decapolis, and from Jerusalem, and from Judaea, and from beyond Jordan.

Matthew 9:35 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, **teaching** in their synagogues, and **preaching** the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing every** sickness and **every** disease among the people.

Acts 2:42 And they continued stedfastly in **the apostles' doctrine** and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. **Acts 2:43** And fear came upon every soul: **and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.**

Acts 5:12 **And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people;** (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch. **Acts 5:13** And of the rest durst no man join himself to them: but the people magnified them. **Acts 5:14** And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.)

Acts 15:12 Then all the multitude kept silence, and gave audience to Barnabas and Paul, **declaring what miracles and wonders God had wrought among the Gentiles by them.**

Acts 19:11 And God wrought **special miracles** by the hands of Paul: **Acts 19:12** So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

2 Corinthians 12:12 Truly **the signs of an apostle** were wrought among you in all patience, in signs, and wonders, and mighty deeds.

8. God heals all → eventually!

Philippians 3:20-21

For our conversation (τὸ πολίτευμα) is in heaven;

from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:

Who shall change (τὸ σῶμα τῆς ταπεινώσεως ἡμῶν) **our vile body,**

that it may be fashioned like unto **his glorious body** (τῷ σώματι τῆς δόξης αὐτοῦ),

according to the working whereby **he is able** even to subdue **all** things unto himself.

1 Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, **1 Peter 1:4** To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you, **1 Peter 1:5** Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

9. God heals most now!

Acts 12:5 Peter therefore was kept in prison: **but prayer was made** without ceasing of the church **unto** God **for** him.

Matthew 7:7 **Ask**, and it shall be given you; **seek**, and ye shall find; **knock**, and it shall be opened unto you:

Matthew 7:8 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall

be opened. **Matthew 7:9** Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone? **Matthew 7:10** Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent? **Matthew 7:11** If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?
