

HEALING & HEALTH PS. 103:3B (2)

Thoughts:

1. God **can** heal all diseases!
2. God **has healed** all diseases!
3. God will heal **all** diseases → eventually!
4. God heals!
5. God & ONLY God heals!
6. God heals **supernaturally, naturally, & unnaturally.**

God never really gives us 3 steps to getting your healing – other than that God is always central!

A. Supernaturally

Acts 12:5 Peter therefore was kept in prison: **but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him.**

Mark 9:29 And he said unto them, **This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.**

B. Naturally

Proverbs 15:13 **A merry heart maketh a cheerful countenance: But by sorrow of the heart the spirit is broken.**

Proverbs 15:15 All the days of the afflicted are evil: **But he that is of a merry heart hath a continual feast.**

Proverbs 17:22 **A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: But a broken spirit drieth the bones.**

Old Puritan Pastor Willam Braitwhite:

3 doctors:

Dr diet

Dr. quiet

Dr. merryman

[Dr. Move your body]

Revelation 22:1 And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. Revelation 22:2 In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, **was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.**

Now: food will eventually kill you

Then: food will eventually heal you

C. Unnaturally***

Proverbs 17:22 A broken spirit drieth the bones.

Colossians 4:14 Luke, the beloved physician, and Demas, greet you.

1 Timothy 5:23 Drink no longer water, but use a little wine for thy stomach's sake and thine often infirmities.

James 5:13 Is any among you afflicted? let him pray. Is any merry? let him sing psalms. James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him **call** for the elders of the church; **and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: James 5:15** And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

2 Chronicles 16:12 And Asa in the thirty and ninth year of his reign was diseased in his feet, until his disease was exceeding great: **yet in his disease he sought not to the LORD, but to the physicians.**

*** The gap between naturally & unnaturally is not as great as we often think. It is more of a continuum. "Natural medicines" still require a very long process.

7. God healed more directly at / during 3 times or eras of revelation

Moses & Joshua:

Elijah & Elisha

Jesus & the Apostles:

Matthew 4:23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, **teaching** in their synagogues, and **preaching** the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing** all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. Matthew 4:24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they

brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them. **Matthew 4:25** And there followed him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and from Decapolis, and from Jerusalem, and from Judaea, and from beyond Jordan.

Matthew 9:35 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, **teaching** in their synagogues, and **preaching** the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing every** sickness and **every** disease among the people.

Acts 2:42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. **Acts 2:43** And fear came upon every soul: **and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.**

Acts 5:12 And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people; (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch. **Acts 5:13** And of the rest durst no man join himself to them: but the people magnified them. **Acts 5:14** And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.)

Acts 15:12 Then all the multitude kept silence, and gave audience to Barnabas and Paul, **declaring what miracles and wonders God had wrought among the Gentiles by them.**

Acts 19:11 And God wrought **special miracles** by the hands of Paul: **Acts 19:12** So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

2 Corinthians 12:12 Truly the signs of an apostle were wrought among you in all patience, in signs, and wonders, and mighty deeds.

Thoughts:

This is stated

This was obvious to all involved!

This cannot be duplicated

This can be redefined

- “star wars miracles”
- God healed my feelings, my pain, my hurt, my cold, my allergies, my back pain...

8. God heals all → eventually!

Philippians 3:20-21

For our conversation (τὸ πολίτευμα) is in heaven;
from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:

Who shall change (τὸ σῶμα τῆς ταπεινώσεως ἡμῶν) **our vile body,**
that it may be fashioned like unto **his glorious body** (τῷ σώματι τῆς δόξης αὐτοῦ),
according to the working whereby **he is able** even to subdue **all** things unto himself.

1 Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, **1 Peter 1:4** To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you, **1 Peter 1:5** Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

9. God heals most now!

Acts 12:5 Peter therefore was kept in prison: **but prayer was made** without ceasing of the church **unto** God **for** him.

Matthew 7:7 **Ask**, and it shall be given you; **seek**, and ye shall find; **knock**, and it shall be opened unto you: **Matthew 7:8** For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. **Matthew 7:9** Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone? **Matthew 7:10** Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent? **Matthew 7:11** If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?
