What have I learned?

Modern healers can come out of the shadows by:

- **Going public**
- **Going silent**
- **Going free**
- **Getting real**

11. Jesus healed with faith, without faith*, and with other people's faith!

With faith:

Matthew 8:10 When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found **so great faith, no, not in Israel.**

Matthew 8:13 And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and **as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee.** And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.

Matthew 9:22 But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; **thy faith hath made thee whole (σέσωκέν).** And the woman was made whole (ἔσωθη) from that hour.

Sooner or later "what faith is" comes into play.

Often faith is seen as feelings / emotions / being pumped up.

Matthew 9:27 And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, Thou Son of David, have mercy on us. Matthew 9:28 And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, **Believe ye that I am able to do this?** They said unto him, Yea, Lord. Matthew 9:29 Then touched he their eyes, saying, **According to your faith be it unto you.**

Ephesians 3:20 **Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, Ephesians 3:21** Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.

Sadly also, the chasing-your-tail...not enough faith, not the right kind of faith...

Without faith*:

A caveat* is always included:

- Sometimes texts don't say
- Sometimes the person could not exercise faith

We usually don't like this because we like a formula (1,2,3...or a,b,c...)

Such as: magic words, name of Jesus, repeat after me...

Matthew 8:14 And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, he saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever.

Matthew 8:15 And he touched her hand, and the fever left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them.

Matthew 8:16 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: **Matthew 8:17** That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.

Matthew 9:18 While he spake these things unto them, behold, there came a certain ruler, and worshipped him, saying, **My daughter is even now dead:** but come and lay thy hand upon her, and she shall live.

Matthew 9:24 He said unto them, **Give place: for the maid is not dead, but sleepeth.** And they laughed him to scorn. **Matthew 9:25** But when the people were put forth, he went in, and took her by the hand, and the maid arose. **Matthew 9:26** And the fame hereof went abroad into all that land.

Matthew 9:32 As they went out, behold, they brought to him a dumb man possessed with a devil. **Matthew 9:33** And when the devil was cast out, the dumb spake: and the multitudes marvelled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel. **Matthew 9:35** And Jesus went about the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

Without faith:

- Not stated
- Unknown
- Impossible
- With, at best...never because of your faith!!!

We can never limit Jesus to someone's faith

With other people's faith:

Matthew 8:5 And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him, **Matthew 8:6** And saying, **Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.** **Matthew 8:7** And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him. **Matthew 8:8** The centurion answered and said, **Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldst come under my roof:** but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.

Matthew 8:10 When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, **Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.**

Matthew 8:13 And Jesus said unto the centurion, **Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee.** And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.

Matthew 9:2 And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: **and Jesus seeing their faith** said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee.

Matthew 9:18 While he spake these things unto them, behold, there came a certain ruler, and worshipped him, saying, **My daughter is even now dead:** but come and lay thy hand upon her, and she shall live.

But not with unbelief...!

- Not just a lack of faith
- But a willing unbelief
- And probably arrogance in the face of proof

Matthew 13:53 And it came to pass, that when Jesus had finished these parables, he departed thence. **Matthew 13:54** And when he was come into his own country, **he taught them in their synagogue, insomuch that they were astonished, and said, Whence hath this man this wisdom, and these mighty works?**

Matthew 13:55 Is not this the carpenter's son? is not his mother called Mary? and his brethren, James, and Joses, and Simon, and Judas? **Matthew 13:56** And his sisters, are they not all with us? **Whence then hath this man all these things?**

Matthew 13:57 And they were offended in him. But Jesus said unto them, **A prophet is not without honour, save in his own country, and in his own house.** **Matthew 13:58** And he did not many mighty works there because of their unbelief.

Mark 6:5 And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon a few sick folk, and healed them. **Mark 6:6** And he marvelled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching.

12. Jesus healed in a variety of ways → too many to normalize!

By his will	8:3
By his word	8:3,13,16
At a distance	8:13
Touch	8:14,15; 9:24-26,29
Indirectly by casting out demons	8:29,31-32; 9:32-34
By being touched	9:20-21

Matthew 8:3 And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, **saying, I will**; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

Matthew 8:13 And Jesus **said** unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.

Matthew 8:16 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits **with his word**, and healed all that were sick:

Matthew 8:13 And Jesus said unto the centurion, **Go thy way**; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. **And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.**

Matthew 8:14 And when Jesus was come into Peter's house, he saw his wife's mother laid, and sick of a fever.

Matthew 8:29 And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with thee, Jesus, thou Son of God? art thou come hither to torment us before the time? **Matthew 8:31** So the devils besought him, saying, If thou cast us out, suffer us to go away into the herd of swine. **Matthew 8:32** And he said unto them, **Go. And when they were come out**, they went into the herd of swine: and, behold, the whole herd of swine ran violently down a steep place into the sea, and perished in the waters.

Matthew 9:32 As they went out, behold, they brought to him a dumb man possessed with a devil.

Matthew 9:34 But the Pharisees said, **He casteth out devils** through the prince of the devils.

Matthew 9:20 And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind him, **and touched the hem of his garment**: **Matthew 9:21** For she said within herself, If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole.

13. Jesus did much more than just heal!

Jesus obviously:

- Walked on water
- Turned water into wine
- Stilled a storm (while in the middle of it)

Mt 8:23-27

- Fed the multitude multiple times!

Matthew 14:21 And they that had eaten were **about five thousand men, beside women and children.**

Matthew 16:9 Do ye not yet understand, **neither remember the five loaves of the five thousand, and how many baskets ye took up?**

Matthew 15:38 And they that did eat were **four thousand men, beside women and children.**

Matthew 16:10 Neither the seven loaves of the four thousand, **and how many baskets ye took up?**

- Raised the dead
- Healed those born blind
- Was raised from the dead!
