## II. Following a process!

Ephesians 5:10 Proving (δοκιμάζοντες) what is acceptable unto the Lord.

1 Thessalonians 5:21-22

Prove (δοκιμάζετε) all things;

hold fast (κατέχετε) that which is good.

**Abstain (ἀπέχεσθε)** from (ἀπὸ) all appearance of evil.

## III. Applying Biblical principles!

<u>1 Corinthians 6:12</u> All things are lawful unto me, <u>but</u> all things are <u>not</u> expedient: all things are lawful for me, <u>but</u> I will not be brought under the power of any.

<u>1 Corinthians 8:9</u> But take heed lest by any means this liberty of yours become a stumblingblock to them that are weak.

<u>1 Corinthians 8:13</u> Wherefore, if meat make my brother to offend, I will eat no flesh while the world standeth, lest I make my brother to offend.

<u>1 Corinthians 10:23</u> All things are lawful for me, <u>but</u> all things are <u>not</u> expedient: all things are lawful for me, <u>but</u> all things edify <u>not</u>.

<u>1 Corinthians 10:24</u> Let no man seek his own, but every man another's wealth.

<u>1 Corinthians 10:31</u> Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, **do all to the glory of God.** <u>1 Corinthians 10:32</u> Give **none offence**, neither to the Jews, nor to the Gentiles, nor to the church of God:

<u>Matthew 5:29</u> And <u>if</u> thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: <u>for</u> it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell.

<u>Matthew 5:30</u> And <u>if</u> thy right hand offend thee, cut it off, and cast it from thee: <u>for</u> it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell.

Philippians 1:9 And this I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all judgment; Philippians 1:10 That ye may approve (δοκιμάζειν) things that are excellent (τὰ διαφέροντα); that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ; Philippians 1:11 Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God.
