<u>Deuteronomy 4:2</u> Ye shall <u>not</u> add unto the word which I command you, <u>neither</u> shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you.

<u>Deuteronomy 12:32</u> What thing soever I command you, observe to do it: thou shalt <u>not</u> add thereto, <u>nor</u> diminish from it.

<u>Deuteronomy 17:20</u> That his heart be not lifted up above his brethren, and that he turn not aside from the commandment, to the <u>right hand</u>, or to the <u>left</u>: to the end that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he, and his children, in the midst of Israel.

<u>Joshua 1:7</u> Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn <u>not</u> from it to the <u>right hand or</u> to the <u>left</u>, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest.

Legalism Lite:

I. Legalism Lite is known for its constant fault - finding

<u>Mark 7:2</u> And when they saw some of his disciples eat bread with defiled, that is to say, with unwashen, hands, they found fault. <u>Mark 7:5</u> Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, <u>Why</u> walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashen hands?

What do we find?

- > Constant fault-finding of others
- > Fault-finding of those closest to them!

This means other Fundamentalists become the enemy.

Real / true liberals are totally unknown.

> **Never** find fault with themselves

<u>1 Corinthians 11:28</u> But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. <u>1 Corinthians 11:31</u> For <u>if</u> we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged.

<u>2 Corinthians 13:5</u> Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; **prove** your own selves. **Know** ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

Remember they can't obey Scripture.

- > **Absolutely** never find fault / question "Dr. So-and-So"
- ➤ Never question their assumptions / mega system

1 Thessalonians 5:21-22

Prove (δοκιμάζετε) all things;

hold fast (κατέχετε) that which is good.

Abstain from (ἀπέχεσθε) all appearance of evil.

1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try (δοκιμάζετε) the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

II. Legalism Lite is known for its ever-growing, extra-Biblical lists

Mark 7:3 For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash their hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders. Mark 7:4 And when they come from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, as the washing of cups, and pots, brasen vessels, and of tables. Mark 7:8 For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do. Mark 7:13 Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.

III. Legalism Lite is known for its non-Biblical (anti-Biblical?) foundation

Mark 7:3 For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash their hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders. Mark 7:4 And when they come from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, as the washing of cups, and pots, brasen vessels, and of tables. Mark 7:5 Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashen hands? Mark 7:7 Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men. Mark 7:8 For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do. Mark 7:18 And he saith unto them, Are ye so without understanding also? Do ye not perceive, that whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, it cannot defile him; Mark 7:19 Because it entereth not into his heart (είς τὴν καρδίαν), but into the belly (ἀλλ' είς τὴν κοιλίαν), and goeth out into the draught (τὸν ἀφεδρῶνα), purging all meats (καθαρίζον πάντα τὰ βρώματα)? Mark 7:20 And he said, That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man.

KJV Mark 7:19 Because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, purging all meats?

NKJV Mark 7:19 because it does not enter his heart but his stomach, and is eliminated, thus purifying all foods?"

ESV Mark 7:19 since it enters not his heart but his stomach, and is expelled?" (Thus he declared all foods clean.)

NASB Mark 7:19 because it does not go into his heart, but into his stomach, and is eliminated?" (Thus He declared all foods clean.)

NIV Mark 7:19 For it doesn't go into his heart but into his stomach, and then out of his body." (In saying this, Jesus declared all foods "clean.")

ASV Mark 7:19 because it goeth not into his heart, but into his belly, and goeth out into the draught? This he said, making all meats clean.

NRSV Mark 7:19 since it enters, not the heart but the stomach, and goes out into the sewer?" (Thus he declared all foods clean.)

3. Legalists don't get after it - make sure you

<u>Mark 7:20</u> And he said, That which cometh **out of** the man, that defileth the man. <u>Mark 7:21</u> For from **within**, **out of the heart** of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, <u>Mark 7:22</u> Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: <u>Mark 7:23</u> All these evil things come **from within**, and defile the man.

Bible Believing Christians always begin with the

<u>Psalm 19:14</u> Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer.

Proverbs 4:23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.

Proverbs 23:19 Hear thou, my son, and be wise, and guide thine heart in the way.

Psalm 119:11 Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.

<u>Psalm 139:23-24</u> Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

Jeremiah 17:9 The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?
