

HE HATH DONE ALL THINGS WELL! Mark 1:40-42; 7:31-37

Assumptions:

- The Lord can...heal, deliver & save!
- The Lord has a sovereign will and His will is determinative!
- Ultimately all healing comes from Him
- Note what you **find** and what you **don't find**!

I. Jesus can heal anyplace / anywhere He pleases!

Mark 7:31 And again, departing from the coasts of Tyre and Sidon, he came unto the sea of Galilee, **through the midst of the coasts of Decapolis.**

Mark 7:24 And from thence he arose, and went **into the borders of Tyre and Sidon**, and entered into an house, and would have no man know it: but he could not be hid.

Mark 1:23 And there was in their **synagogue** a man with an unclean spirit; and he cried out,

Mark 1:29 And forthwith, when they were **come out of the synagogue, they entered into the house** of Simon and Andrew, with James and John.

Mark 1:32 And at even, when the sun did set, they brought unto him all that were diseased, and them that were possessed with devils.

Mark 1:33 And all the city was gathered together **at the door.** **Mark 1:34** And he healed many that were sick of divers diseases....

Mark 1:39 And he preached **in their synagogues throughout all Galilee**, and cast out devils.

Mark 1:40 And there came a leper to him, beseeching him, and kneeling down to him, and saying unto him, If thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.

Mark 2:1 And again he entered into Capernaum after some days; and it was noised that he was **in the house.** **Mark 2:2** And straightway many were gathered together, insomuch that there was no room to receive them, no, not so much as about the door: and he preached the word unto them.

Mark 3:1 And he entered again **into the synagogue**; and there was a man there which had a withered hand. **Mark 3:2** And they watched him, whether he would heal him on the sabbath day; that they might accuse him.

Mark 3:7 But Jesus withdrew himself with his disciples **to the sea**; and a great multitude from Galilee followed him, and from Judaea, **Mark 3:8** And from Jerusalem, and from Idumaea, and from beyond Jordan; and they about Tyre and Sidon, a great multitude, when they had heard what great things he did, came unto him. **Mark 3:9** And he spake to his disciples, that a small ship should wait on him because of the multitude, lest they should throng him. **Mark 3:10** For he had healed many....

Mark 5:1 And they came over unto the other side of the sea, into the country of the **Gadarenes.**

Mark 5:2 And when he was come out of the ship, immediately there met him **out of the tombs** a man with an unclean spirit,

Mark 5:24 And Jesus went with him; **and much people followed him, and thronged him.** **Mark 5:25** And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years, **Mark 5:26** And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse, **Mark 5:27** When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment.

Mark 5:38 And he cometh **to the house of the ruler of the synagogue**, and seeth the tumult, and them that wept and wailed greatly.

Mark 5:40 And they laughed him to scorn. But when he had put them all out, he taketh the father and the mother of the damsel, and them that were with him, and entereth in where the damsel was lying.

II. Jesus can heal any way He pleases!

- At a distance, apart from faith and knowledge

Mark 7:29 And he said unto her, For this saying go thy way; the devil is gone out of thy daughter. **Mark 7:30** And when she was come to her house, she found the devil gone out, and her daughter laid upon the bed.

- Yucky yuck!

Mark 7:33 And he took him aside from the multitude, and put his fingers into his ears, and he spit, and touched his tongue; **Mark 7:34** And looking up to heaven, he sighed, and saith unto him, Ephphatha, that is, Be opened.

- Words

Mark 1:25 And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him.

- Touch --kind of!

Mark 1:31 And he came and took her by the hand, and lifted her up; and immediately the fever left her, and she ministered unto them.

- Unknown

Mark 1:34 And he healed many that were sick of divers diseases, and cast out many devils; and suffered not the devils to speak, because they knew him.

➤ **Faith of four men + words**

Mark 2:5 When Jesus saw their faith, he said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee. **Mark 2:11** I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy bed, and go thy way into thine house.

➤ **Words**

Mark 3:5 And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched it out: and his hand was restored whole as the other.

➤ **Touch -- kind of!**

Mark 3:10 For he had healed many; insomuch that they pressed upon him for to touch him, as many as had plagues. **Mark 3:11** And unclean spirits, when they saw him, fell down before him, and cried, saying, Thou art the Son of God.

➤ **Command to the demon**

Mark 5:8 For he said unto him, Come out of the man, thou unclean spirit.

➤ **Touch...kind of + faith**

Mark 5:27 When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment.

Mark 5:28 For she said, If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole. **Mark 5:34** And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague.

➤ **Faith of a father + unbelief of the friends + words**

Mark 5:36 As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, he saith unto the ruler of the synagogue, Be not afraid, only believe.

Mark 5:40 And they laughed him to scorn. But when he had put them all out, he taketh the father and the mother of the damsel, and them that were with him, and entereth in where the damsel was lying. **Mark 5:41** And he took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi; which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, arise.

III. Jesus can heal anyone He pleases!

Mark 7:25 For a certain woman, whose young daughter had an unclean spirit, heard of him, and came and fell at his feet: **Mark 7:26** The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought him that he would cast forth the devil out of her daughter.

Mark 7:31 And again, departing from the coasts of Tyre and Sidon, he came unto the sea of Galilee, through the midst of the coasts of Decapolis.

Mark 1:23 And there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit; and he cried out,

Mark 1:30 But Simon's wife's mother lay sick of a fever, and anon they tell him of her.

Mark 1:31 And he came and took her by the hand, and lifted her up; and immediately the fever left her, and she ministered unto them.

Mark 1:34 And he healed many that were sick of divers diseases, and cast out many devils; and suffered not the devils to speak, because they knew him.

Mark 1:40 And there came a leper to him, beseeching him, and kneeling down to him, and saying unto him, If thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. **Mark 1:41** And Jesus, moved with compassion, put forth his hand, and touched him, and saith unto him, I will; be thou clean. **Mark 1:42** And as soon as he had spoken, immediately the leprosy departed from him, and he was cleansed.

Mark 2:4 And when they could not come nigh unto him for the press, they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they had broken it up, they let down the bed wherein the sick of the palsy lay.

Mark 3:1 And he entered again into the synagogue; and there was a man there which had a withered hand.

Mark 3:10 For he had healed many; insomuch that they pressed upon him for to touch him, as many as had plagues.

Mark 5:1 And they came over unto the other side of the sea, into the country of the Gadarenes.

Mark 5:2 And when he was come out of the ship, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit, **Mark 5:9** And he asked him, What is thy name? And he answered, saying, My name is Legion: for we are many.

Mark 5:22 And, behold, there cometh one of the rulers of the synagogue, Jairus by name; and when he saw him, he fell at his feet,

Mark 5:23 And besought him greatly, saying, My little daughter lieth at the point of death: I pray thee, come and lay thy hands on her, that she may be healed; and she shall live.

Mark 5:25 And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years,

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
