# BASIC OPTIONS, BIBLICAL AND OTHER... MT. 19:1-14

When thinking Biblically about marriage, divorce, remarriage...it is important to have a sense of priorities and proportion that the Bible itself establishes.

Matthew 19:1 And it came to pass, that when Jesus had finished these sayings, he departed from Galilee, and came into the coasts of Judaea beyond Jordan; Matthew 19:2 And great multitudes followed him; and he healed them there. Matthew 19:3 The Pharisees also came unto him, tempting him, and saying unto him, Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife for every cause? Matthew 19:4 And he answered and said unto them, Have ye not read, that he which made them at the beginning made them male and female, Matthew 19:5 And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh? Matthew 19:6 Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder. Matthew 19:7 They say unto him, Why did Moses then command to give a writing of divorcement, and to put her away? Matthew 19:8 He saith unto them, Moses because of the hardness of your hearts suffered you to put away your wives: but from the beginning it was not so. Matthew 19:9 And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, except it be for fornication, and shall marry another, committeth adultery: and whoso marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery. Matthew 19:10 His disciples say unto him, If the case of the man be so with his wife, it is not good to marry. Matthew 19:11 But he said unto them, All men cannot receive this saying, save they to whom it is given. Matthew 19:12 For there are some eunuchs, which were so born from their mother's womb: and there are some eunuchs, which were made eunuchs of men: and there be eunuchs, which have made themselves eunuchs for the kingdom of heaven's sake. He that is able to receive it, let him receive it.

### 1<sup>st</sup>: Stay single!

Matthew 19:10 His disciples say unto him, If the case of the man be so with his wife, it is not good to marry. Matthew 19:11 But he said unto them, All men cannot receive this saying, save they to whom it is given. Matthew 19:12 For there are some eunuchs, which were so born from their mother's womb: and there are some eunuchs, which were made eunuchs of men: and there be eunuchs, which have made themselves eunuchs for the kingdom of heaven's sake. He that is able to receive it, let him receive it.

<u>1 Corinthians 7:1</u> Now concerning the things whereof ye wrote unto me: It is **good** for a man not to touch a woman. <u>1</u> Corinthians 7:2 Nevertheless, to avoid fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband.

<u>1 Corinthians 7:7</u> For I would that all men were even as I myself. But every man hath his proper gift of God, one after this manner, and another after that. <u>1 Corinthians 7:9</u> But <u>if</u> they cannot contain, let them marry: for it is <u>better</u> to marry than to burn.

#### The single life:

- **➢** Given to some
- ➤ Not given to all / even most
- ➤ Might be given for a while / a period of time
- Can be given for various reasons
  Born that way
  Made / forced
  Chosen
  - > Can only be received as a gift

### 2<sup>nd</sup>: God's original intent: Marriage, no divorce and no remarriage!

<u>1 Corinthians 7:2</u> Nevertheless, to avoid fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband. <u>1 Corinthians 7:9</u> But <u>if</u> they cannot contain, let them marry: for it is better to marry than to burn. <u>1 Corinthians 7:10</u> And unto the married I command, yet not I, but the Lord, Let **not** the wife depart from her husband:

<u>Luke 16:18</u> Whosoever putteth away his wife, and marrieth another, committeth adultery: and whosoever marrieth her that is put away from her husband committeth adultery.

<u>Mark 10:11</u> And he saith unto them, Whosoever shall put away his wife, and marry another, committeth adultery against her. <u>Mark 10:12</u> And if a woman shall put away her husband, and be married to another, she committeth adultery.

## 3<sup>rd</sup>: The fall-back position: Divorce and no remarriage

<u>Luke 16:18</u> Whosoever putteth away his wife, **and marrieth another**, committeth adultery: **and whosoever marrieth her** that is put away from her husband committeth adultery.

<u>Mark 10:11</u> And he saith unto them, Whosoever shall put away his wife, **and marry another**, committeth adultery against her. <u>Mark 10:12</u> And if a woman shall put away her husband, **and be married to another**, she committeth adultery.

<u>1 Corinthians 7:10</u> And unto the married I command, yet <u>not</u> I, <u>but</u> the Lord, Let <u>not</u> the wife depart from her husband: <u>1</u> Corinthians 7:11 But and <u>if</u> she depart, let her remain <u>unmarried</u>, or be <u>reconciled</u> to her husband: and let <u>not</u> the husband put away his wife.

### 4th: The exception(s): Divorce and remarriage for very limited reasons

Matthew 5:31 It hath been said, Whosoever shall put away his wife, let him give her a writing of divorcement: Matthew 5:32 But I say unto you, That whosoever shall put away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication (πορνείας), causeth her to commit adultery: and whosoever shall marry her that is divorced committeth adultery.

Matthew 19:9 And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, except it be for fornication (πορνεί $\phi$ ), and shall marry another, committeth adultery: and whoso marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery.

1 Corinthians 7:12 But to the rest speak I, not the Lord: If any brother hath a wife that believeth not, and she be pleased to dwell with him, let him not put her away. 1 Corinthians 7:13 And the woman which hath an husband that believeth not, and if he be pleased to dwell with her, let her not leave him. 1 Corinthians 7:14 For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband: else were your children unclean; but now are they holy. 1 Corinthians 7:15 But if the unbelieving depart, let him depart. A brother or a sister is not under bondage in such cases: but God hath called us to peace.

#### This assumes:

- > People who divorce almost inevitably remarry
- > The problem really is in the remarriage and <u>not</u> the divorce
- > Remarriage should not be the first choice
- > Remarriage can only be if there is an exception
- > Remarriage is never commanded
- > Remarriage is only allowed

#### How many exceptions are there?

<u>Luke 16:18</u> Whosoever putteth away his wife, and marrieth another, committeth adultery: and whosoever marrieth her that is put away from her husband committeth adultery.

<u>Mark 10:11</u> And he saith unto them, Whosoever shall put away his wife, **and marry another**, committeth adultery against her. <u>Mark 10:12</u> And if a woman shall put away her husband, **and be married to another**, she committeth adultery.
