

NE SUPRA CREPIDAM!

1 Timothy 4:7 But refuse profane and old wives' fables, and exercise thyself rather unto godliness. **1 Timothy 4:8** For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.

If you have type 2 diabetes...

1 Timothy 6:20 O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science (γνώσεως) falsely so called: **1 Timothy 6:21** Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. Grace be with thee. Amen.

2 Timothy 2:16 But shun profane and vain babblings: **for** they will increase unto more ungodliness.

2 Timothy 2:23 But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, **knowing** that they do gender strifes.

2 Timothy 4:2 Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. **2 Timothy 4:3** For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; **2 Timothy 4:4** **And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.** **2 Timothy 4:5** But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

Titus 1:14 Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, that turn from the truth.

Titus 3:9 But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; **for they are unprofitable and vain.** **Titus 3:10** A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject; **Titus 3:11** Knowing that he that is such is subverted, and sinneth, being condemned of himself.

Simple thoughts:

2 Timothy 1:12 For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

Job 19:25 For I know that my redeemer liveth, And that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth:

1 John 5:13 These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.

2. Know what you **don't know!**

Conspiracies ALWAYS play on &/ appeal to pride

- **Pride of knowledge**
- **Pride of being right &/ unique**
- **Pride of being against the “something” (deep state, Illuminati. . .)**

Ne Supra Crepidam = Not beyond the shoe!!!

Pliny the Elder in his Natural History introduces us to 2 proverbial phrases from the Greco-Roman world:

In Vino Veritas – In Wine There is Truth

Ne Supra Crepidam: Not Beyond the Shoe

Ultracrepidarian: offering opinions they know

Stated of Eusebius: He knew an awful lot, it is less clear how much he understood!

4. Know what you **shouldn't** know | attempt to know!

Ephesians 5:12 For it is a shame even to speak of those things which are done of them in secret.

1 Corinthians 13:4 Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,

1 Corinthians 13:5 Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;

1 Corinthians 13:6 Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth;

1 Corinthians 13:7 Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.

1 Corinthians 8:1 Now as touching things offered unto idols, **we know that we all have knowledge.**

Knowledge puffeth up, but charity edifieth.

1 Corinthians 8:2 And **if** any man think that he knoweth any thing, he knoweth nothing yet as he ought to know.

1 Corinthians 8:3 But **if** any man love God, the same is known of him.
