<u>2 Timothy 4:16</u> At my first answer **no man** stood with me, <u>but</u> all men forsook me: I pray God that it may not be laid to their charge. <u>2 Timothy 4:17</u> Notwithstanding the Lord stood with me, and strengthened me; that by me the preaching might be fully known, and that all the Gentiles might hear: and I was delivered out of the mouth of the lion. <u>2</u> <u>Timothy 4:18</u> And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom be glory for ever and ever.
