Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD:


Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.


Deuteronomy 6:6 And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart:



Habits / habits of the heart:

1. Acknowledge God for ALL that He is!

Deuteronomy 6:4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD:

Everything changes | everything ends | life is inherently unstable <u>BUT</u>:

- >There is a God
- **≻**God is the Lord
- **>**God is one -not many gods

➤ God created the universe!

Genesis 1:1 IN the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

- > He is our God!
- He is the God of Abraham, Isaac, & Jacob!

 Genesis 50:24 And Joseph said unto his brethren, I die: and God will surely visit you, and bring you out of this land unto the land which he sware to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob.

Exodus 2:24 And God heard their groaning, and God remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob.

Exodus 3:6 Moreover he said, I am the God of thy failer, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.

Exodus 3:15 And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel. The Lord God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations.

<u>1 Peter 1:3</u> **Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ**, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again <u>unto</u> a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, <u>1 Peter 1:4 To</u> an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you, <u>1 Peter 1:5</u> Who are kept by the power of God through faith <u>unto</u> salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

The NT reveals this **MOTE** but it's **also** in the OT:

1 John 4:19 We love him, because he first loved us.

Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

Deuteronomy 7:6 For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath **Chosen like** to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth.

Deuteronomy 7:7 The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye were the fewest of all people:

Deuteronomy 7:8 But because the Lord loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.

Deuteronomy 10:12 And now, Israel, what doth the LORD thy God require of thee, but to fear the LORD thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the LORD thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul, Deuteronomy 10:13 To keep the commandments of the LORD, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good?
