# A SACRED SUMMARY GAL. 5:6

#### Galatians 5:6

For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love. Paul gives us a summary → **assuming** you & I know it's a summary of the book and the Gospel!

Right key → right car!

Galatians 5:6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.

#### 1. Salvation is not by circumcision

Galatians 5:6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.

We must be very careful here and <u>not</u> miss the point!

Paul is <u>not</u> discussing the OT saints / OT faith / OT salvation.

He uses shorthand — circumcision to describe in general a work-based religion!
Works + faith

- >613 commands
- >Plus many traditions
- >Plus our attempt to keep them & save ourselves
- **▶Plus God...& grace...somewhere!**

Lost was the substitution of sacrifices pointing to Christ!

Lost was Christ → the Messiah!

Genesis 22:8 And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together.

John 1:29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

John 1:35 Again the next day after John stood, and two of

his disciples;

John 1:36 And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith,

Behold the Lamb of God!

The OT is full of Grace & Faith looking forward to the Messiah & the cross!

As John repeatedly shows!

John 8:56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad.

John 8:57 Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham?

John 8:58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, Verily, I say unto

you, Before Abraham was, I am.

John 1:40 One of the two which heard John speak, and followed him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.

John 1:41 He first findeth his own brother Simon, and saith unto him, We have found the Messias, which is, being interpreted, the Christ.

John 1:45 Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.

Circumcision points to the tendency of religion to move to faith + works, legalism, works -based salvation, &/ saving yourself.

Romans 10:1 Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be saved.

Romans 10:2 For I bear them record that they have a zeal of God, but not according to knowledge.

Romans 10:3 For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God.

Romans 10:4 For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.

Galatians 5:6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.

#### 2. Salvation is <u>not</u> by uncircumcision!

<u>Galatians 5:6</u> For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, <u>nor uncircumcision</u>; but faith which worketh by love.

Galatians 4:8 Howbeit then, when ye knew not God, ye did service unto them which by nature are no gods.

Galatians 4:9 But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?

Galatians 4:10 Ye observe days, and months, and times, and years.

Galatians 4:11 I am afraid of you, lest I have bestowed upon you labour in vain.

Galatians 5:6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.

#### 3. Salvation is through faith!

Galatians 5:6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; **but faith** which worketh by love.

A Sacred Summary:

- **≻**By grace alone
- >Through faith alone
- **►In Christ alone**

Galatians 1:3 Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ,

Galatians 1:4 Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father:

Galatians 1:5 To whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Galatians 2:16 **Knowing** that a man is <u>not</u> justified by the works of the law, <u>but</u> by the faith of Jesus Christ, **even we** have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and <u>not</u> by the works of the law: <u>for</u> by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

Galatians 3:6 Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.

Galatians 3:11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: ior, The just shall live by faith.

Galatians 3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:

Galatians 4:4 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, Galatians 4:5 To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

Salvation begins with:
I'm at the wrong car
I have / am using the wrong key

Salvation is Christ → He is the key & the car!

Galatians 5:6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith **Which Worketh** by love.

## 4. Salvation is through faith alone **resulting in** good works!

Galatians 5:6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith **Which Worketh** by love.

#### 4 logical possibilities:

Works → salvation

Faith + works  $\rightarrow$  salvation

Faith → salvation + no inevitable good works

Faith  $\rightarrow$  salvation  $\rightarrow$  good works

### Faith alone saves But the faith that saves is never alone!

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Ephesians 2:9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus **Unio good Works**, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

John 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.

Galatians 5:6 For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh **by love.** 

## 5. Salvation begins with the love of God for us & ends with our love for Him!
