

UNDER HIS GRACE

Titus 3:15 All that are with me salute thee. Greet them that love us in the faith. **Grace be with you all.** Amen.

Titus 1:4 To Titus, mine own son after the common faith: **Grace**, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour.

Titus 2:11 For **the grace of God** that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,

Titus 3:7 That **being justified by his grace**, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Titus, much like most of Paul's epistles, begins and ends with grace.

Under His grace OR on your own!

Titus 2:11 For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,

Titus 2:14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

Under His grace OR on your own!

1. Salvation⁺⁺⁺ ~~out of~~ grace!

Titus 2:11 For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,

Titus 2:14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

2:11 is bigger, greater, & started long before you & I existed!

Romans 5:12 Wherefore, as **by one man** sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

1 Corinthians 15:22 For as **in Adam** all die, even so **in Christ** shall all be made alive.

Man sinned in the garden – obviously!
Adam represented us – federal headship
He did what we would have done IF we had
been there!

He did what we continually do no!

Romans 3:10 As it is written, There is none righteous,
no, not one:

Romans 3:23 For all have sinned (ἥμαρτον), and
come short (ὑστεροῦνται) of the glory of God;

We say this reverently – God had 2 choices:

1. Do nothing → you are on your own!

2. Do something → under His grace

Titus 3:7 That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Romans 3:21 But now the righteousness of God **without** the law is manifested, **being witnessed by the law and the prophets;**

Romans 3:22 Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:

Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

Romans 3:24 Being justified **freely** by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

Facts about us all:

- **All are guilty – no exceptions**
- **All are without excuse**
- **We can't justify ourself**
- **God justifies us – declares us righteous**

➤ God does so **freely**

➤ God does so **by His grace**

His unmerited favor AND actions for us!

➤ God does so because of the redemption in Christ – price has been paid

Romans 11:6 And if by grace, then is it no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if it be of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work.

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

Ephesians 2:9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Acts 20:32 And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to **the word of his grace**, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.
