Our questions:

What are the Jews? What makes a Jew a Jew?

4 characteristics:

1. One God and **ONLY** one God!

2. One law & all other laws under them (The Torah)

3. One Land | Homeland

Genesis 15:18 In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, **Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates:**

Genesis 17:1 And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect. Genesis 17:2 And I will make my covenant between me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly. Genesis 17:3 And Abram fell on his face: and God talked with him, saying, Genesis 17:4 As for me, behold, my covenant is with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many nations. Genesis 17:5 Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee. Genesis 17:6 And I will make thee exceeding fruitful, and I will make nations of thee, and kings shall come out of thee.

Genesis 17:7 And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations **for an everlasting covenant**, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee.

Genesis 17:8 And **I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, the land wherein thou art a stranger, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession;** and I will be their God.

Many Jew haters say: I don't hate the Jews only the Zionists!!!

- The Jews were given a land
- The Jews had a kingdom in that land from 1400 BC~ to 586 BC
- Then a country under various empires...
- The Jews have always lived in that land

Even after the 1st Jewish Revolt 66-70/73 & the 2nd Jewish Revolt of Simon bar Kokhba Kosiba 132-135

- That land is theirs by divine gifting
- The Jews **returned** in numbers from the late 1800s & especially after 1947/48
- The Jews have not returned in belief- yet!
- The Jews have brought back & absorbed 22,000 beta Israel from Ethiopia
- Plus all those expelled from "Muslim" lands since 1948...

4. The Jews are God's chosen people

John 4:22 Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: **for salvation is of the Jews.**

Romans 3:1 What advantage then hath the Jew? or what profit is there of circumcision? Romans 3:2 **Much every way:** chiefly, because that unto them were committed the oracles of God.

Deuteronomy 7:1 When the LORD thy God shall bring thee into the land whither thou goest to possess it, and hath cast out many nations before thee, the Hittites, and the Girgashites, and the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites, seven nations greater and mightier than thou; Deuteronomy 7:2 And when the LORD thy God shall deliver them before thee; thou shalt smite them, and utterly destroy them; thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor shew mercy unto them:

Deuteronomy 7:3 Neither shalt thou make marriages with them; thy daughter thou shalt not give unto his son, nor his daughter shalt

thou take unto thy son. **Deuteronomy 7:4** For they will turn away thy son from following me, that they may serve other gods: so will the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and destroy thee suddenly. **Deuteronomy 7:5** But thus shall ye deal with them; ye shall destroy their altars, and break down their images, and cut down their groves, and burn their graven images with fire.

Deuteronomy 7:6 For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth.

Deuteronomy 7:7 The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye were the fewest of all people:

Deuteronomy 7:8 But because the LORD loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.

Deuteronomy 9:4 Speak not thou in thine heart, after that the LORD thy God hath cast them out from before thee, saying, **For** my righteousness the LORD hath brought me in to possess this land: but for the wickedness of these nations the LORD doth drive them out from before thee. **Deuteronomy 9:5** Not for thy righteousness, or for the uprightness of thine heart, dost thou go to possess their land: but for the wickedness of these nations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee, and that he may perform the word which the LORD swore unto thy fathers, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. **Deuteronomy 9:6** Understand therefore, that the LORD thy God giveth thee not this good land to possess it for thy righteousness; for thou art a stiffnecked people.

5. The Messiah comes from the Jews and is Jewish!

This adds several levels to the hatred and crazy:

- **Demonic**
- **Irrational**
- **Unprofitable**

Genesis 3:15 And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

Exodus 1:16 And he said, When ye do the office of a midwife to the Hebrew women, and see them upon the stools; **if it be a son, then ye shall kill him:** but if it be a daughter, then she shall live.

Exodus 1:22 And Pharaoh charged all his people, saying, **Every son that is born ye shall cast into the river,** and every daughter ye shall save alive.

2 Kings 11:1 And when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, **she arose and destroyed all the seed royal.** **2 Kings 11:2** But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons which were slain; and they hid him, even him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

Esther 3:8 And Haman said unto king Ahasuerus, There is a certain people scattered abroad and dispersed among the people in all the provinces of thy kingdom; and their laws are diverse from all people; neither keep they the king's laws: therefore it is not for the king's profit to suffer them. **Esther 3:9** If it please the king, let it be written that they may be destroyed: and I will pay ten thousand talents of silver to the hands of those that have the charge of the business, to bring it into the king's treasures.

Esther 3:10 And the king took his ring from his hand, and gave it unto Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, **the Jews' enemy.**

Esther 3:11 And the king said unto Haman, The silver is given to thee, the people also, to do with them as it seemeth good to thee.

Matthew 2:16 Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wroth, **and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Beth-lehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under,** according to the time which he had diligently inquired of the wise men.

Revelation 12:1 And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars: **Revelation 12:2** And she being with child cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered.

Revelation 12:3 And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns, and seven crowns upon his heads.

Revelation 12:4 And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: **and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.**
